### **Summary**

# Key findings

- 59 syndrome cases reported from 4 sites data was collected from
  - TTMH Paediatrics reported 0 syndrome case
- Influenza-like-illness, 47 cases (17.9% of encounters)
- Acute Fever and Rash, 6 cases (2.3% of encounters)
- 1 case for Dengue-like-illness (0.4% of encounters)
- 7 Diarrhoea cases (2.7% of encounters)

#### Conclusion and recommendations

• ILI, AFR, Diarrhoea and DLI are ongoing amongst the Samoans population.

Current outbreaks or public health incidents of importance to the Forumthat are occurring in the region and globally

<u>Coverage</u>: 3 points of care are included in the enhanced syndromic surveillance system. For the date indicated above, <u>4</u> points of care submitted reports. Only **3** sites reported syndrome cases.
