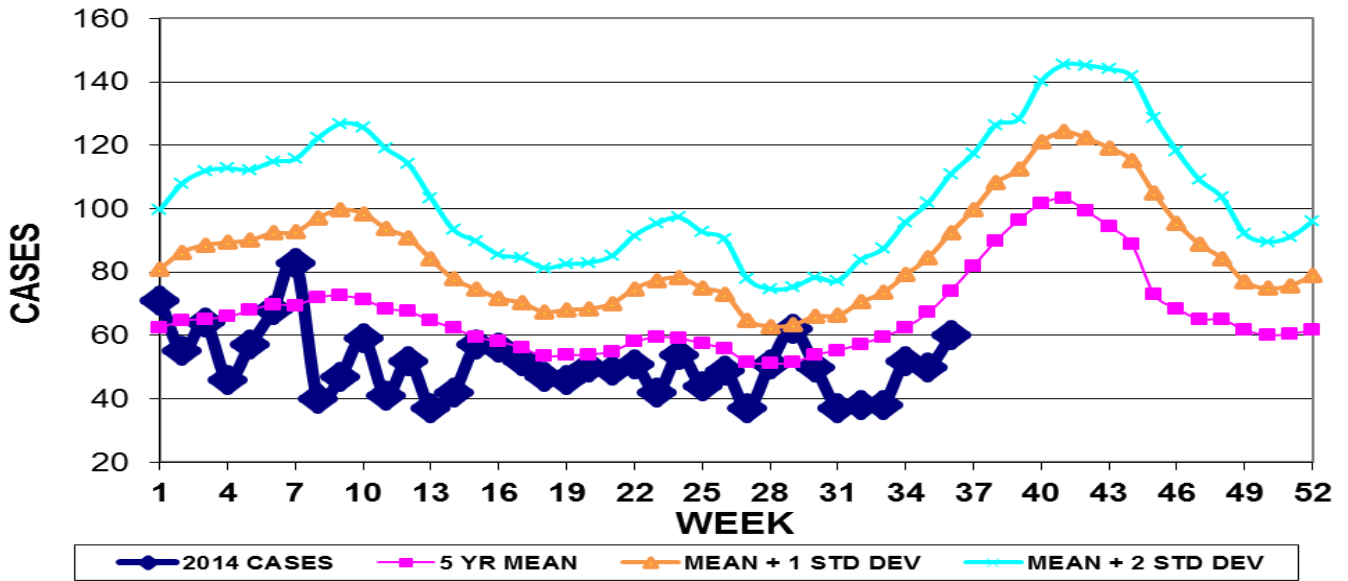

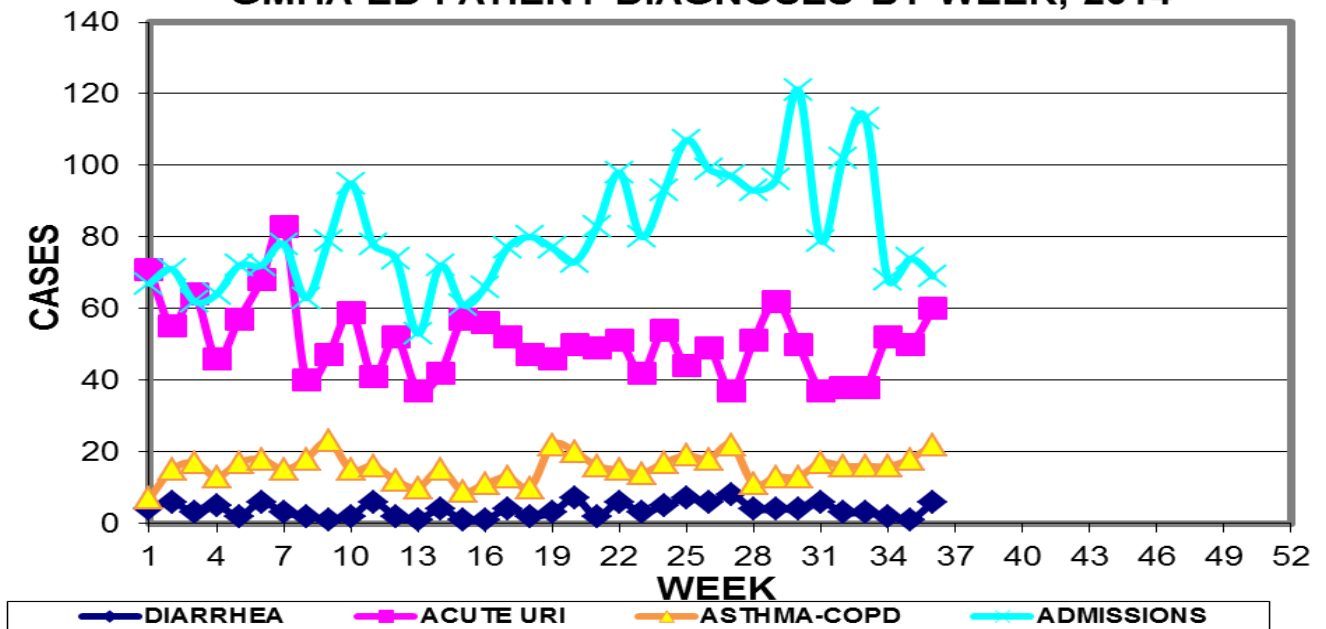

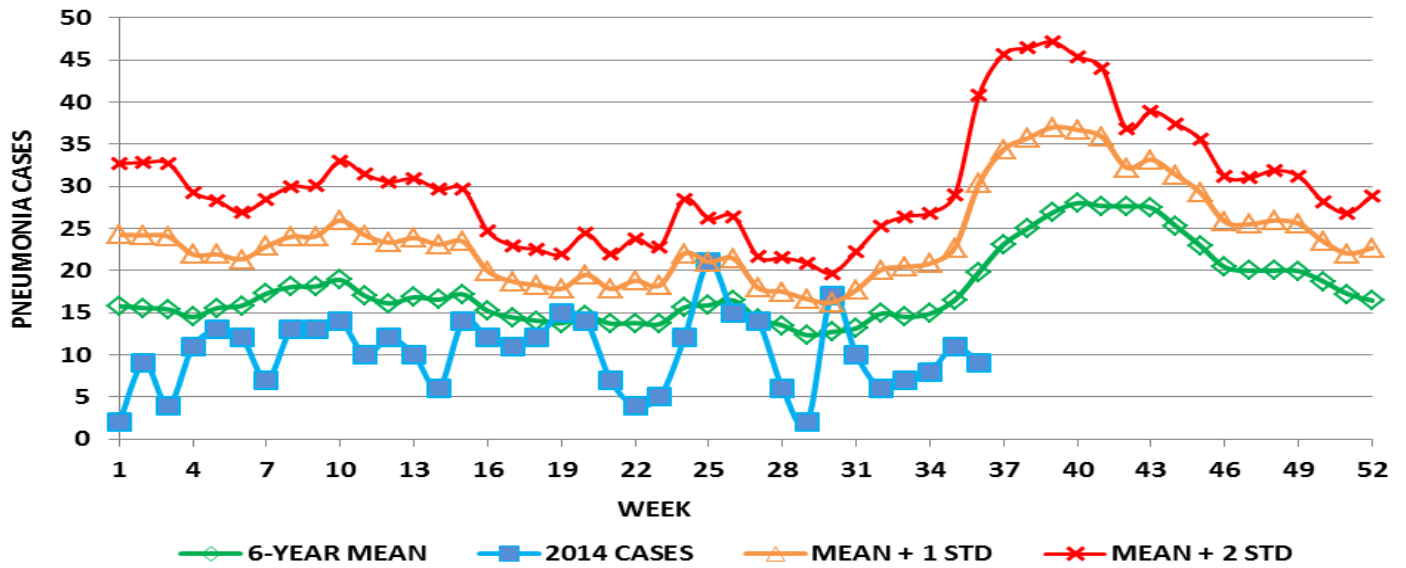
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY INFECTION SURVEILLANCE 2014;  
 GMHA-EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT PATIENTS BY WEEK SEEN**



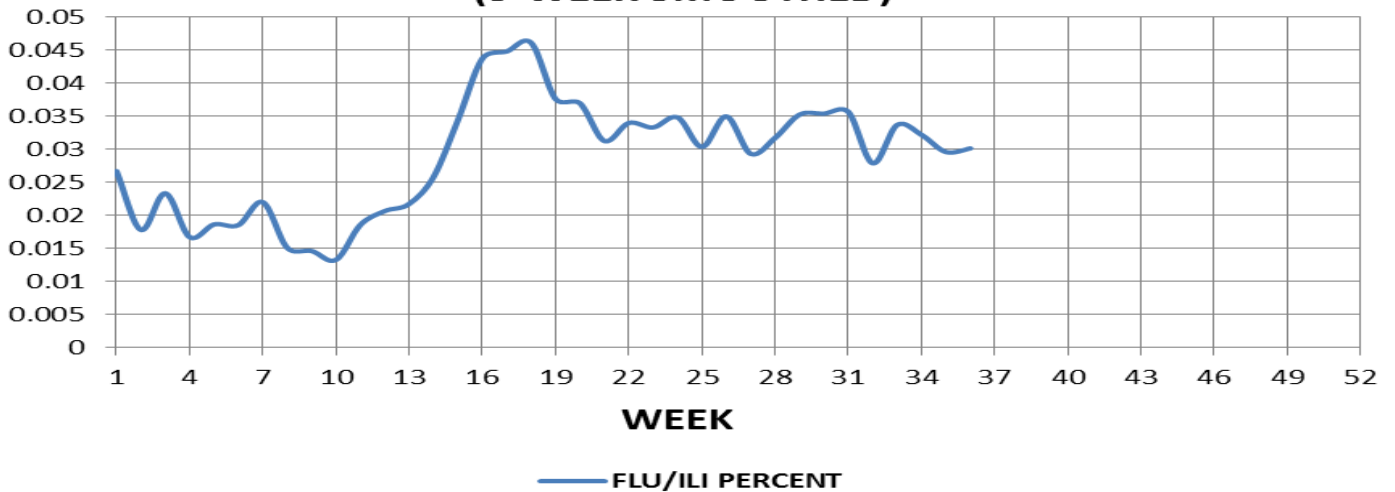
**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE
