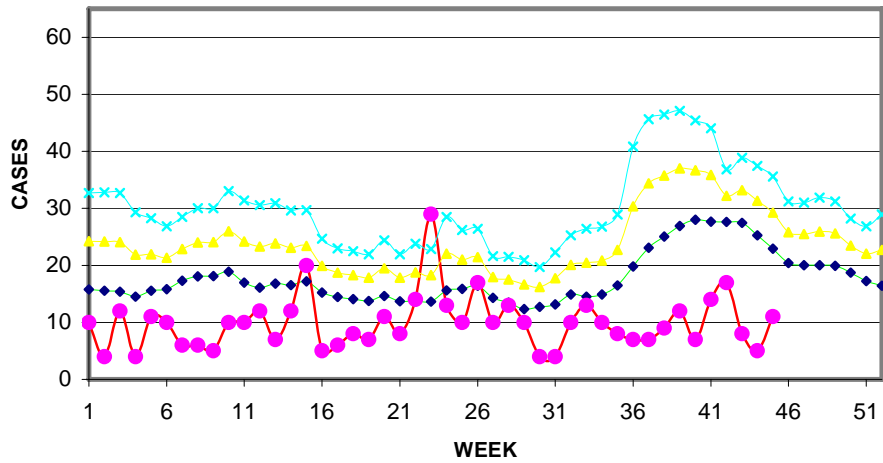
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY DISEASE SURVEILLANCE, 2006;

 GMHA-ED PATIENT DIAGNOSES BY WEEK FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2006**

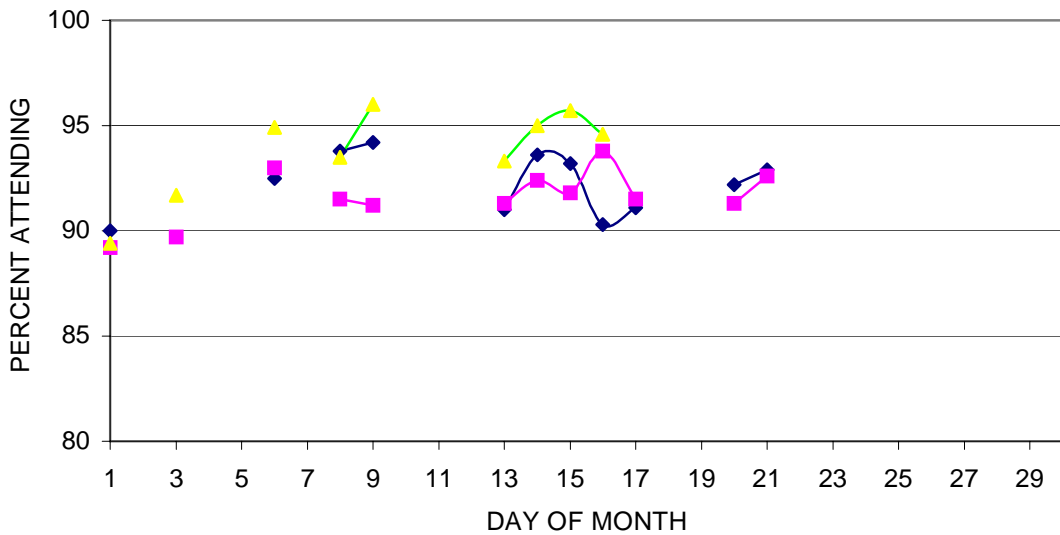

**BY WEEK DISCHARGED, 2006**



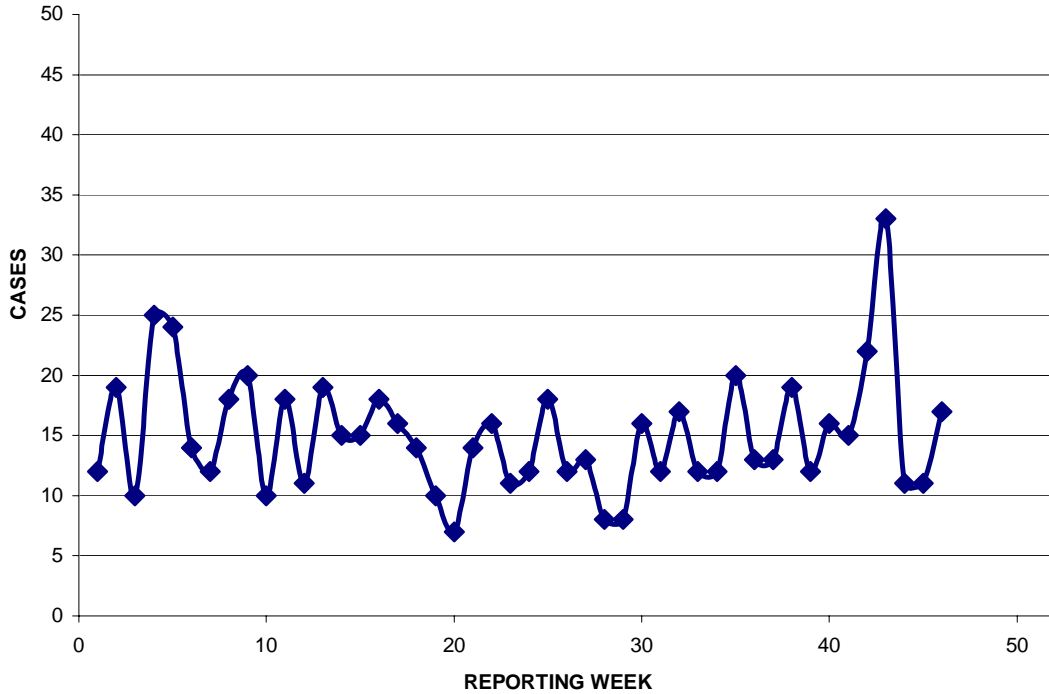
◆ 6-YEAR MEAN

**PERTUSSIS**

As of November 10, 2006, the number of confirmed pertussis cases remains unchanged at 7 and the number of probable cases at 45. Thirteen suspect cases are currently under investigation, the most recent having cough onset on 11/11/06 .
