





HOSPITAL INPATIENT DISCHARGES WITH DIAGNOSIS OF PNEUMONIA BY WEEK DISCHARGED, 2007




GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE BY REGION: DAILY PERCENT ATTENDING, FEBRUARY 2007
