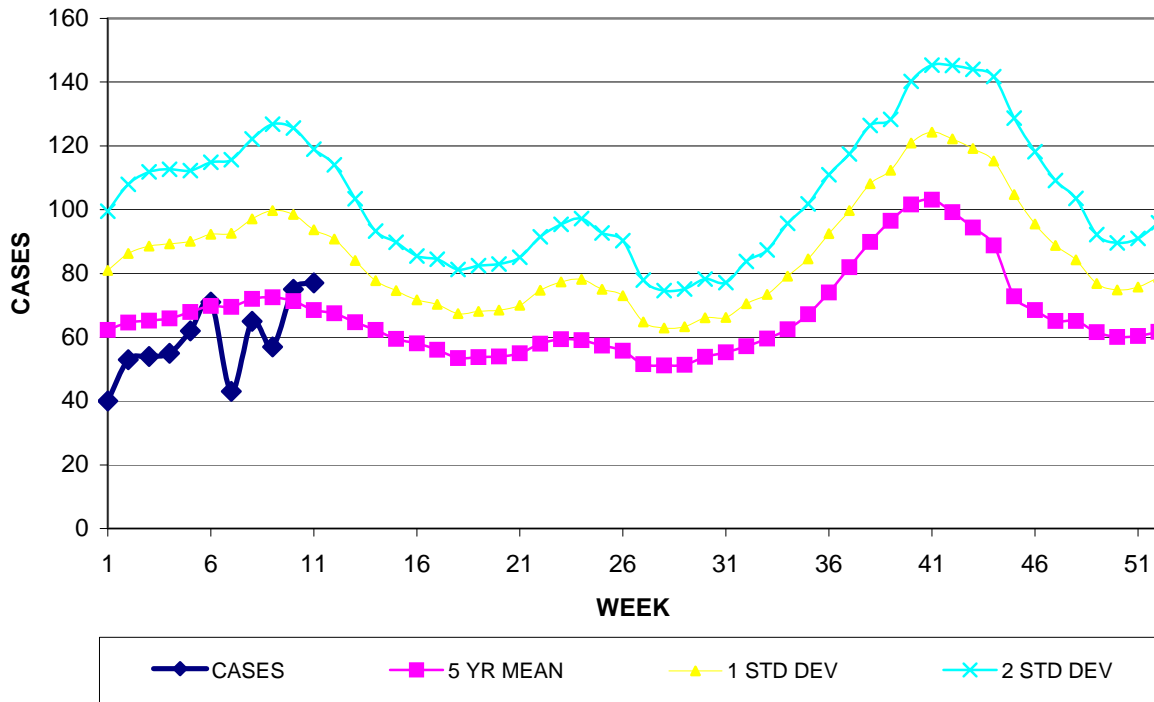

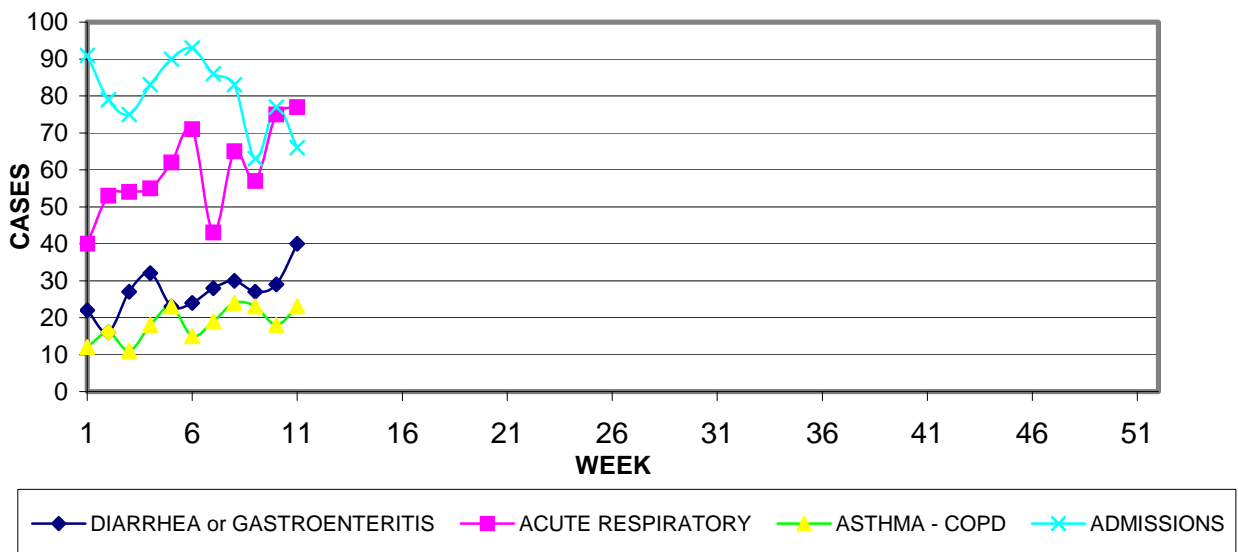

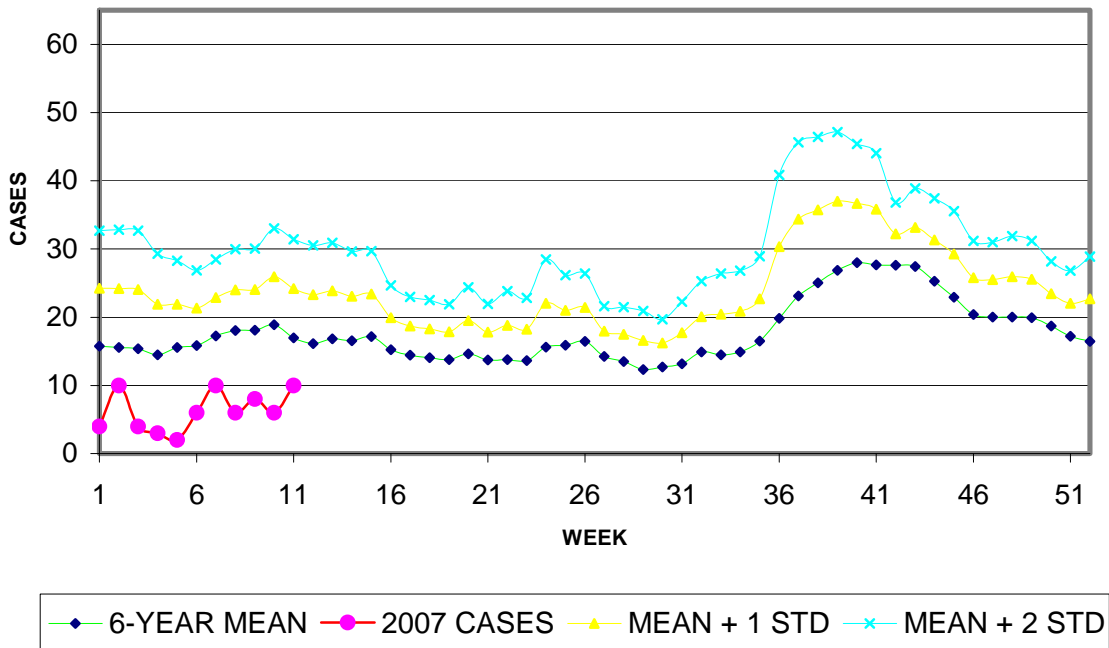
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY DISEASE SURVEILLANCE, 2007;  
 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**



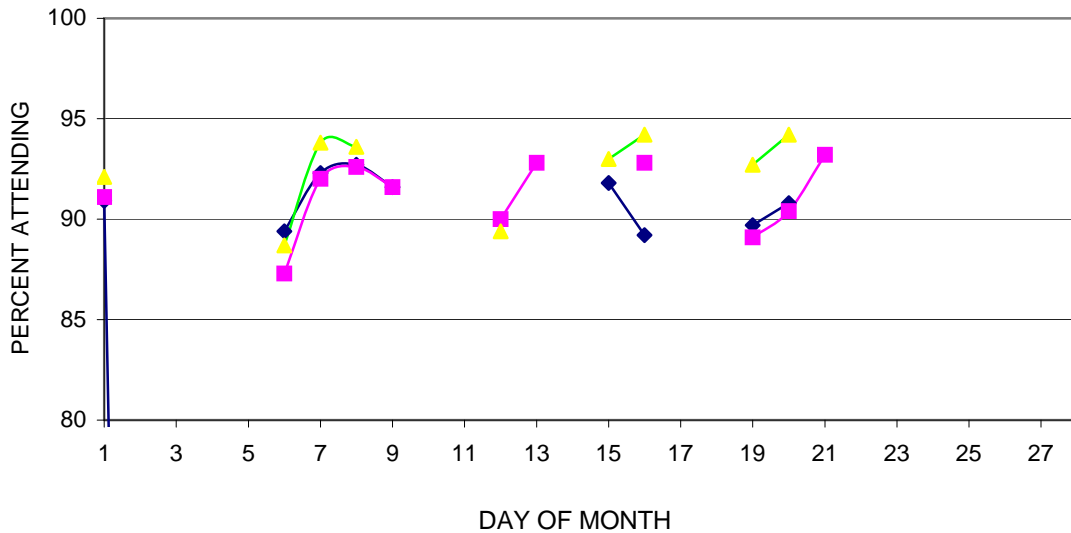
**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE  
 GMHA-ED PATIENT DIAGNOSES BY WEEK FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2007**



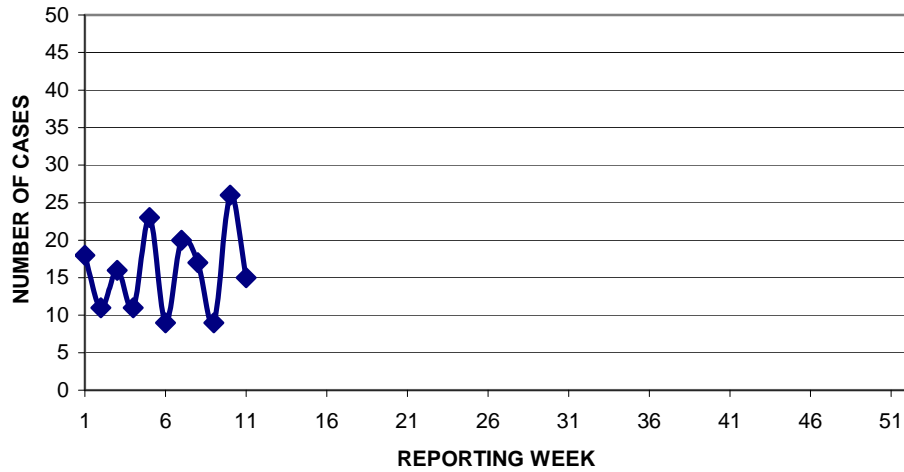
