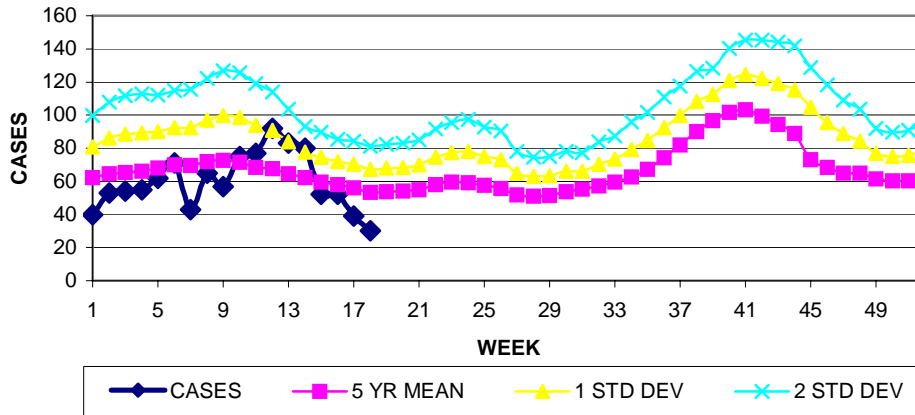


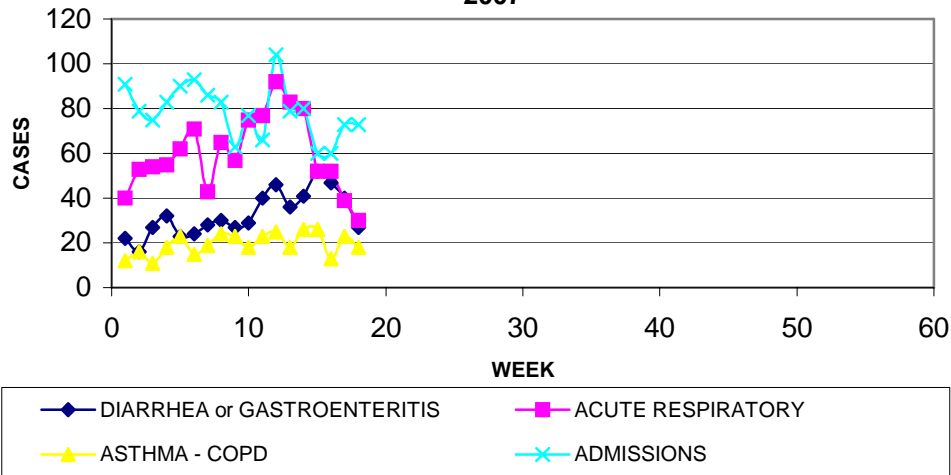

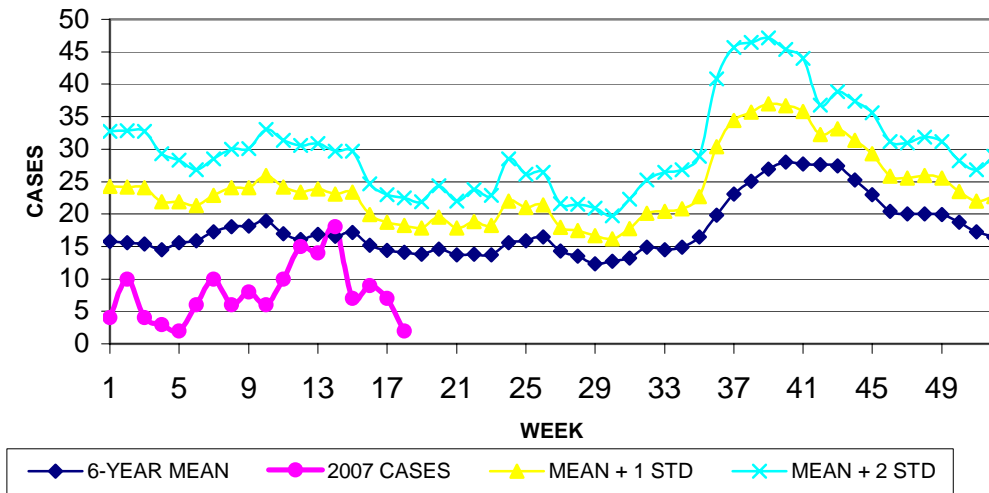
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY INFECTION SURVEILLANCE, 2007;
 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**



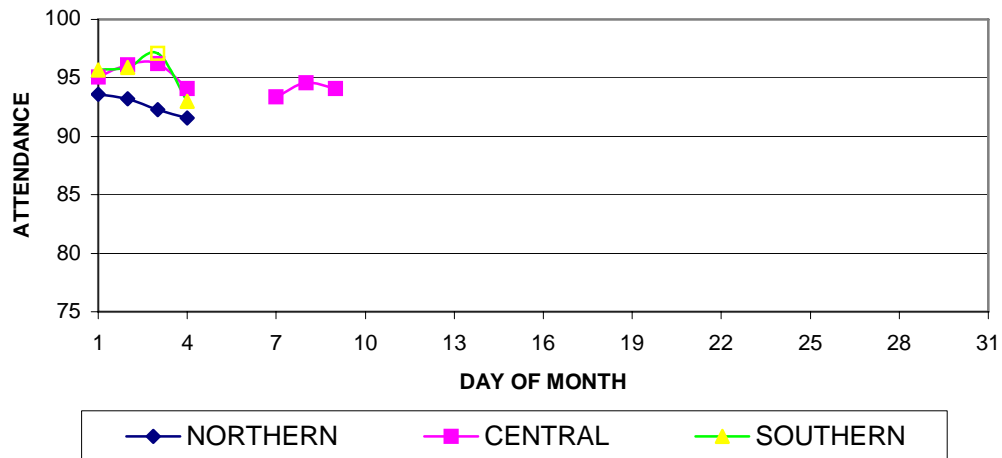
**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE

 2007**



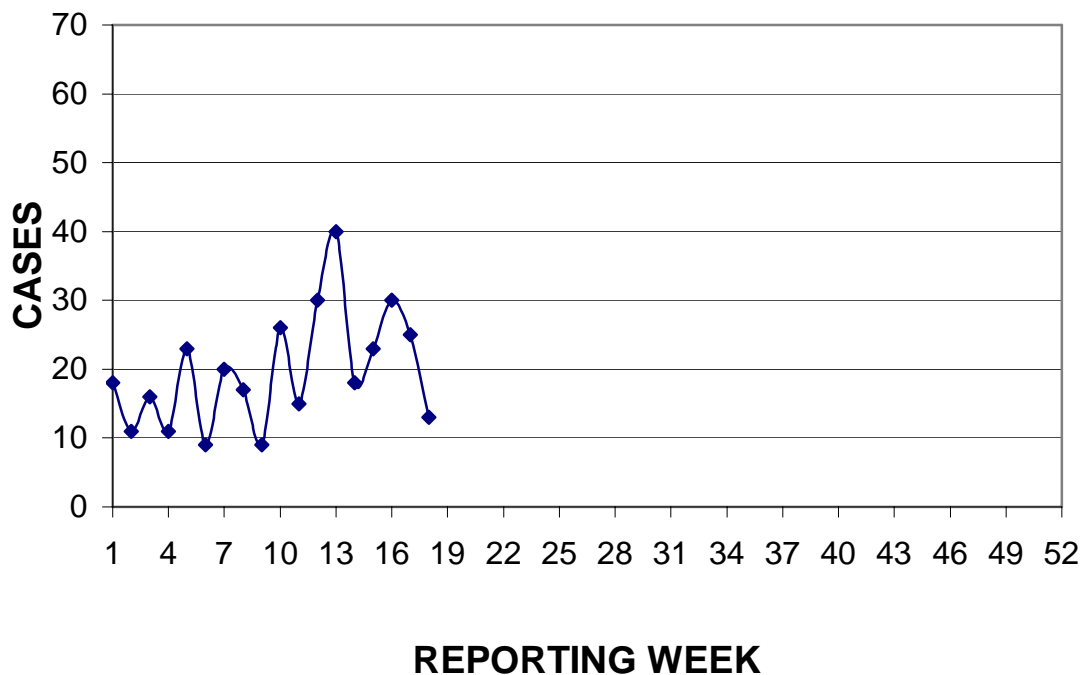
