

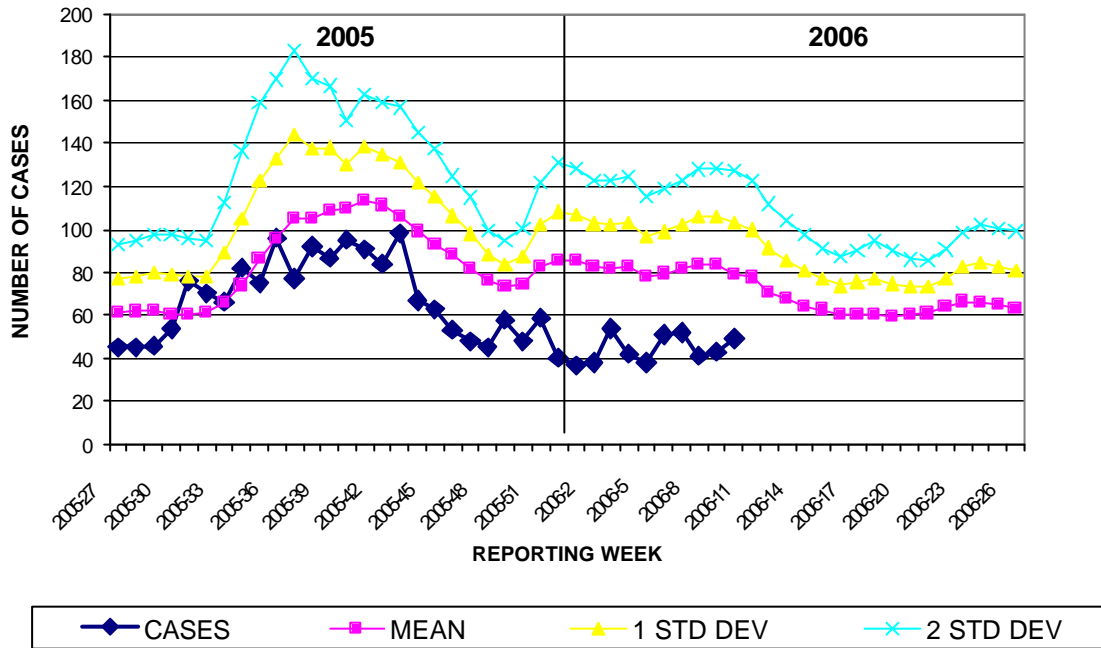

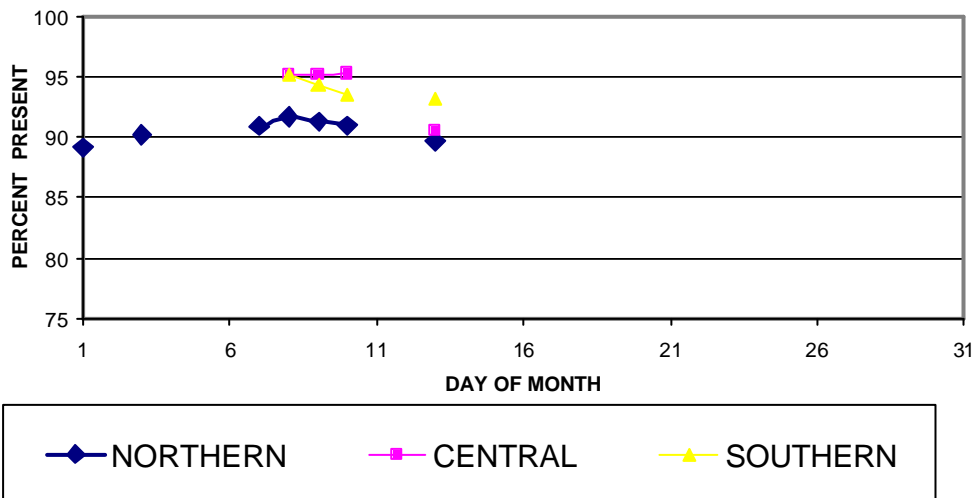
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY DISEASE SURVEILLANCE;
 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**



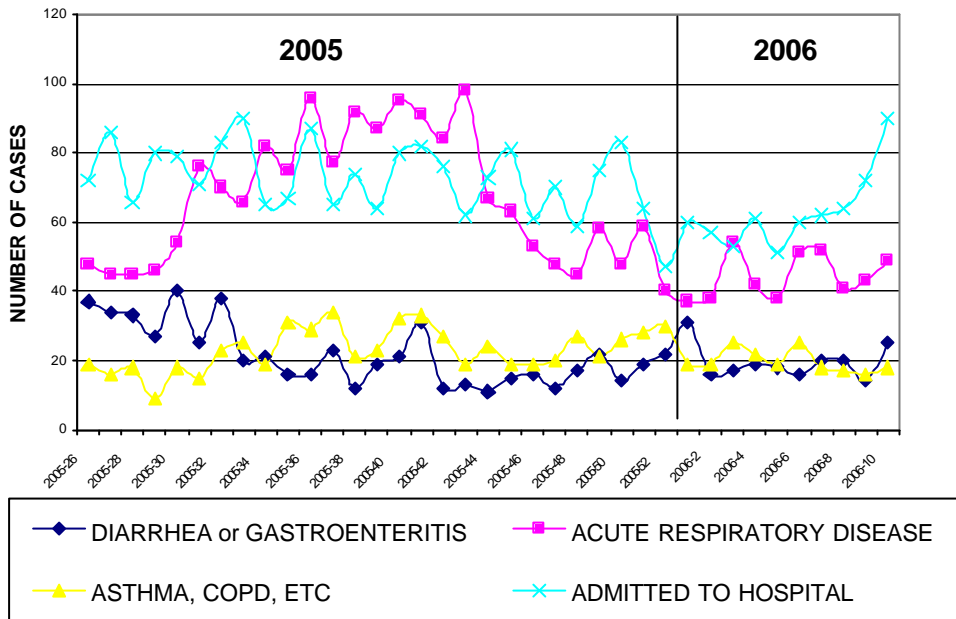

March 2006 (Reporting weeks 10-13)

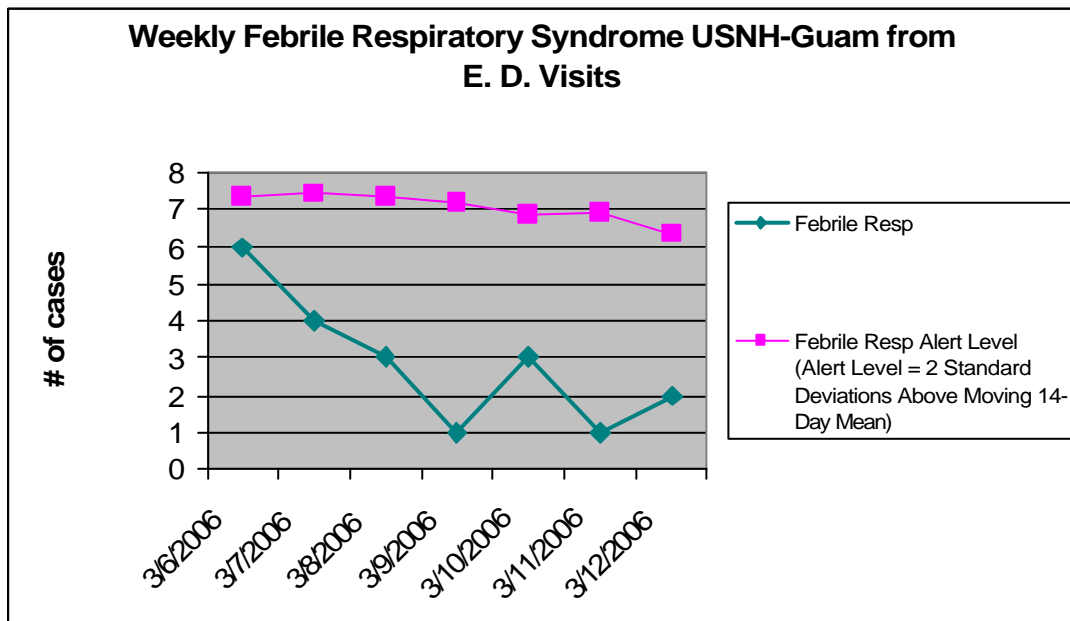


Guam Syndromic Disease Surveillance by Week: Data from the GMHA-ED Log for the Period from 7-3-2005 Through 7-1-2006



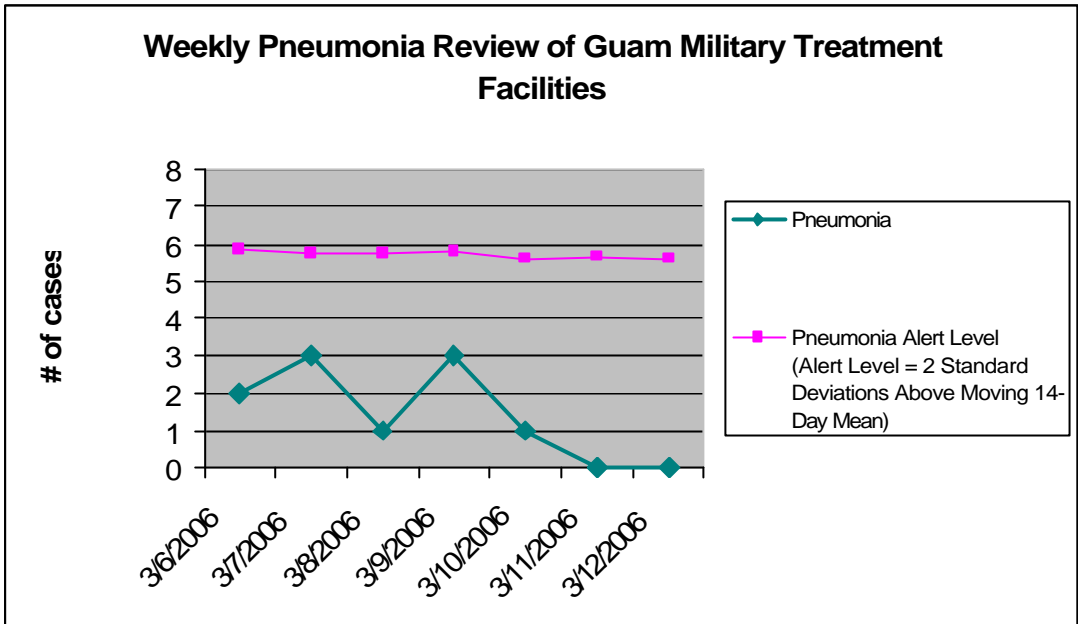
U.S. NAVY (GUAM) REPORT

I. Febrile respiratory cases identified via USNH E.D. visit review.



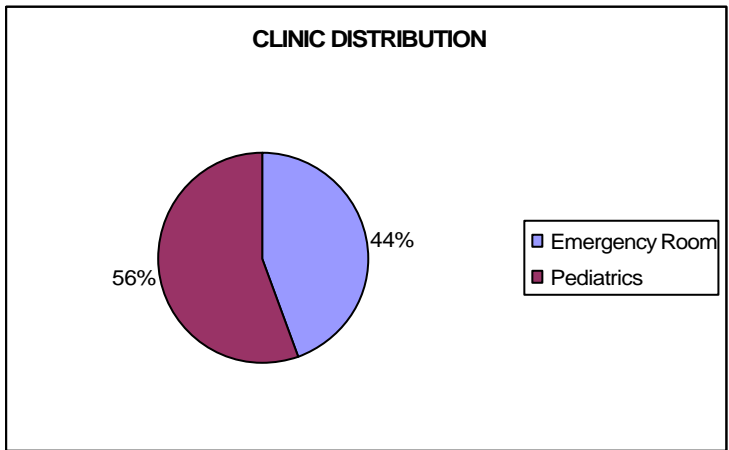

II. Incidences of pneumonia identified via USNH E.D. visit review, DOD web-based Syndromic Surveillance review, and Preventive Medicine rounds of Inpatient Clinics.



For the period of 6 MAR to 12 MAR 2006:

- Ten cases of pneumonia were identified.
- Nine of the ten cases were identified at Naval Hospital Guam.
