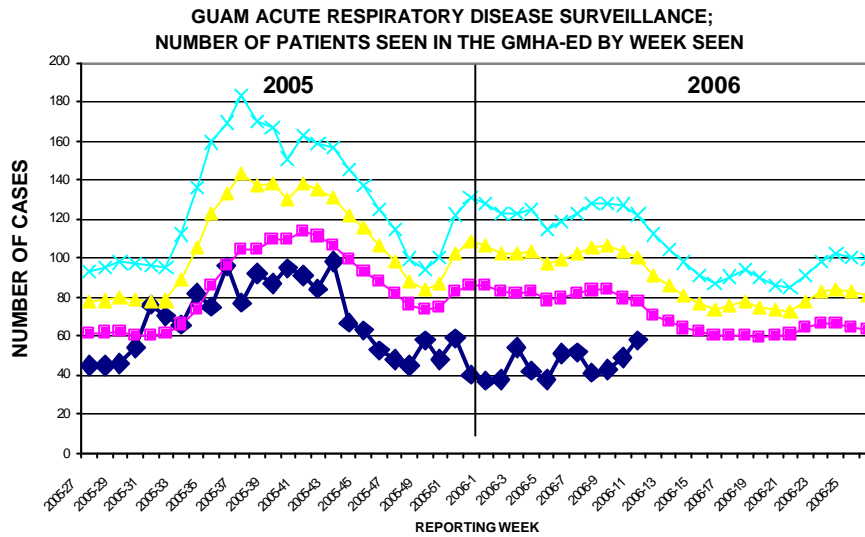

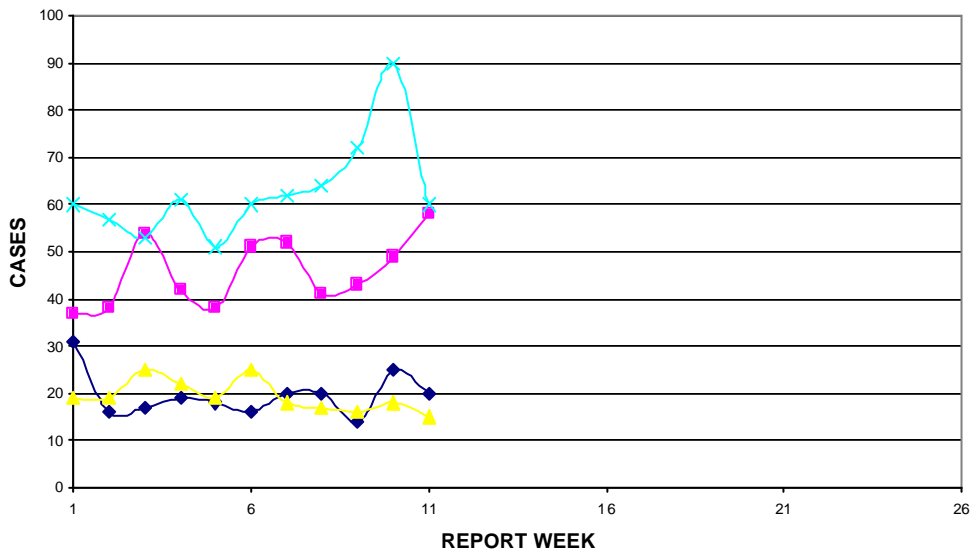

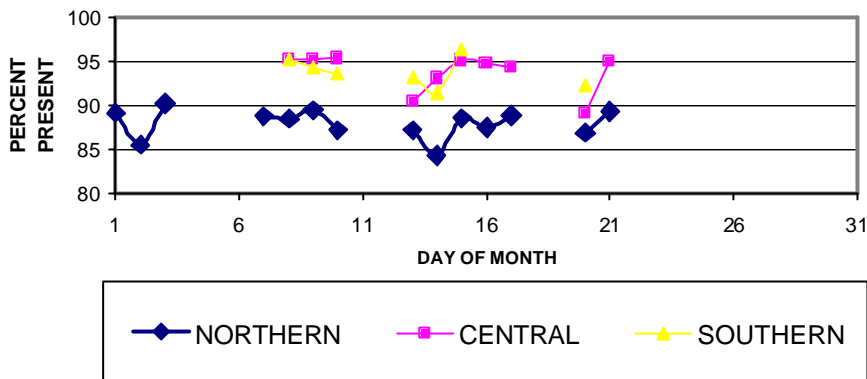

 FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1-1-2006 THROUGH 6-30-2006**

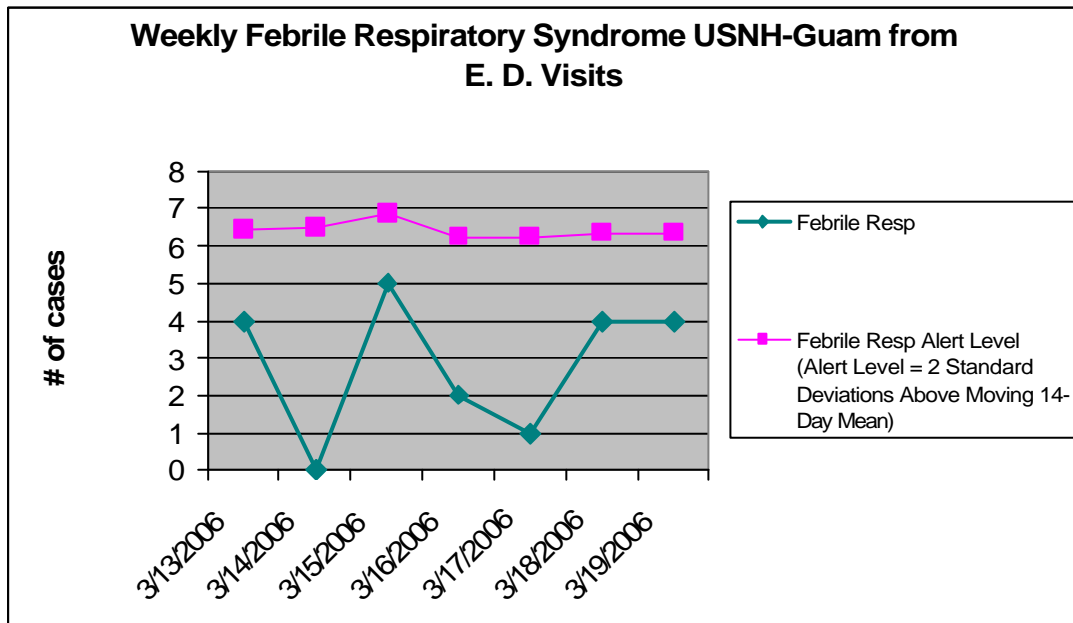


**DAILY GUAM SCHOOL ATTENDANCE BY REGION
March 2006 (Reporting weeks 10-13)**

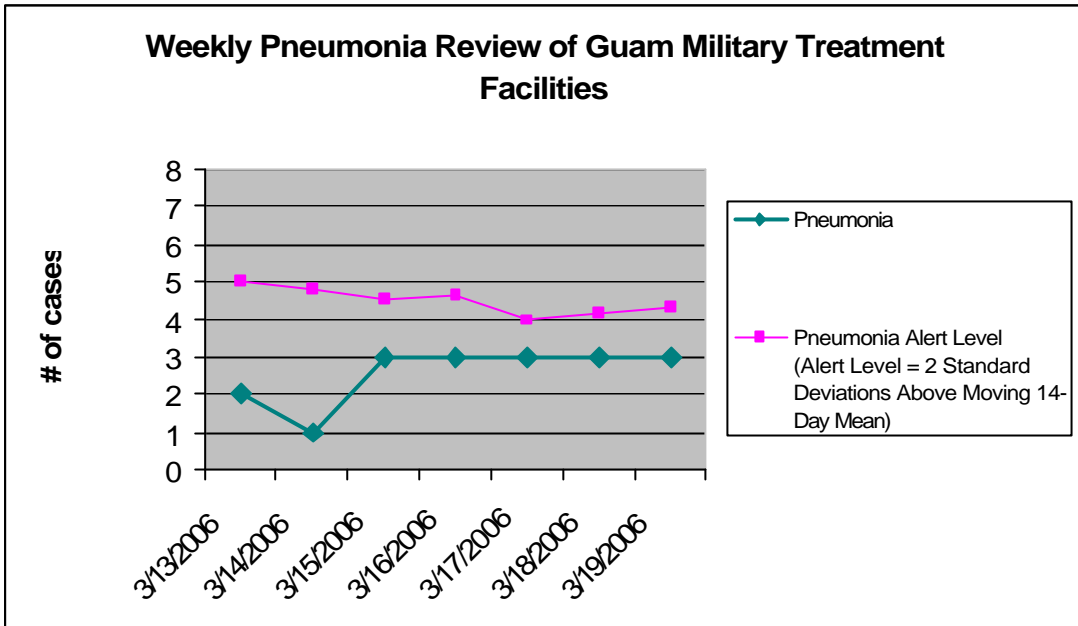

I. Febrile respiratory cases identified via USNH E.D. visit review.

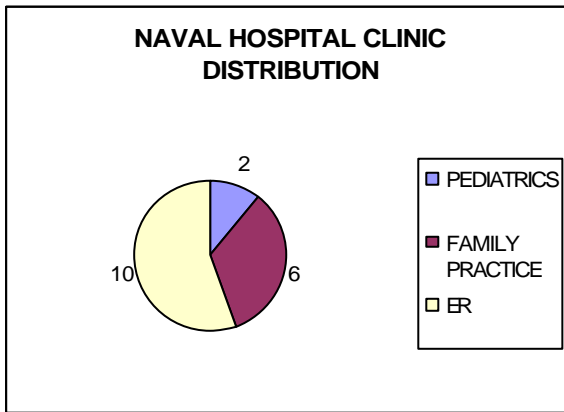
