

I. Febrile respiratory cases identified via USNH E.D. visit review.




? Upon review of essence, an increase in febrile illnesses for the region was noted on 27 March 2006. There were also increases in febrile illnesses identified at USNH Guam on 31 March 2006 and at BMC Naval Station Guam on 28 March 2006.

II. Incidences of pneumonia identified via USNH E.D. visit review, DOD web-based Syndromic Surveillance review, and Preventive Medicine rounds of Inpatient Clinics.



For the period of 27 MAR to 2 APR 2006:

- Eighteen cases of pneumonia were identified.
- All 18 cases were identified at Naval Hospital Guam.
- One patient was admitted for Community Acquired Pneumonia.
