



# **GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE SURVEILLANCE**





I. Febrile respiratory cases identified via USNH E.D. visit review.






For the period of 1 MAY to 7 MAY 2006:

- Fourteen cases of pneumonia were identified.
- Thirteen cases were identified at Naval Hospital Guam. One case was identified at Andersen Family Practice (AFP).
- Distribution by clinic as follows.
