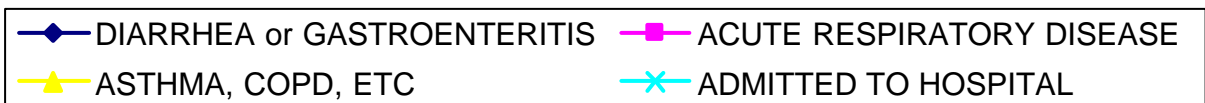

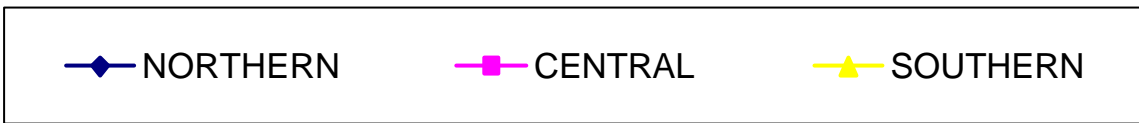
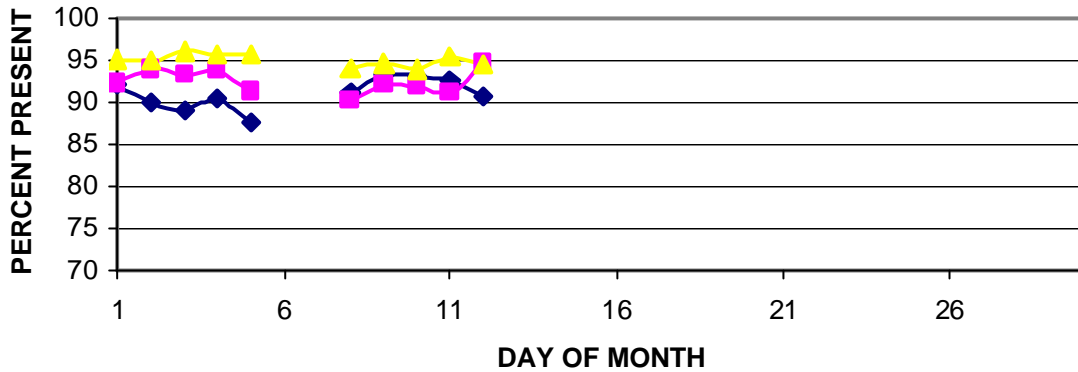
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY DISEASE SURVEILLANCE;

 GMHA-ED DATA FOR THE PERIOD 7-1-2005 THROUGH 6-31-2006**

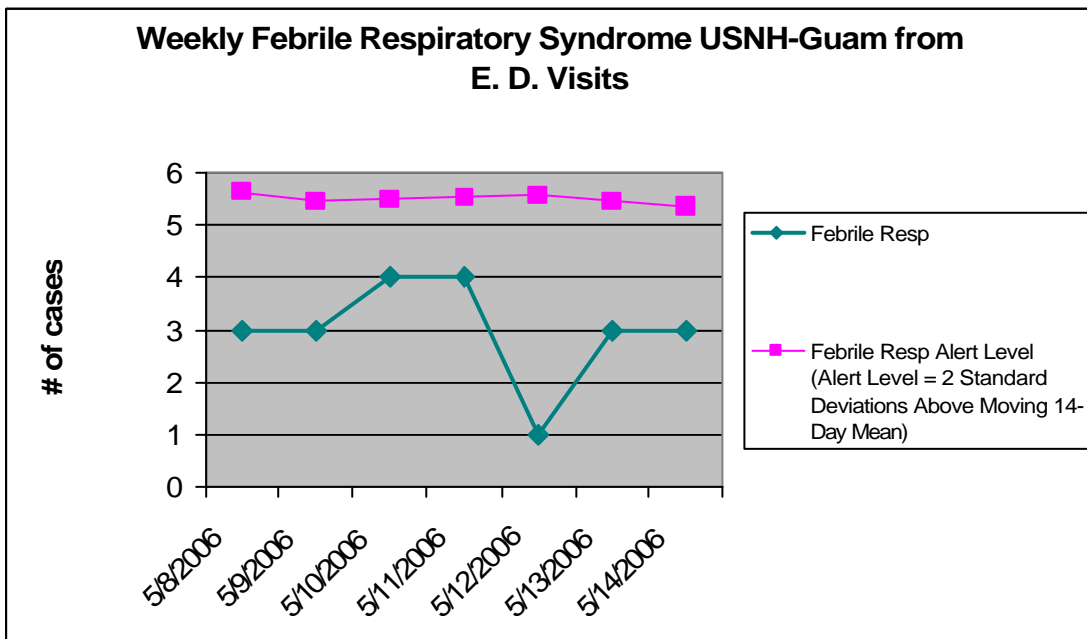


GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE SURVEILLANCE MAY 2006 (REPORTING WEEKS 18 - 22)

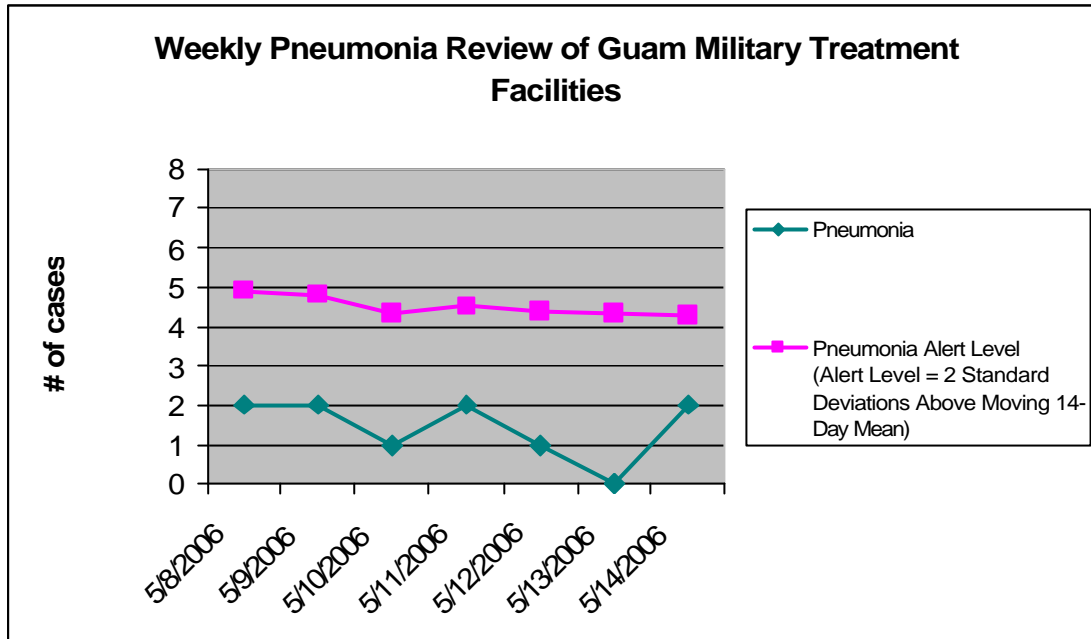

I. Febrile respiratory cases identified via USNH E.D. visit review.

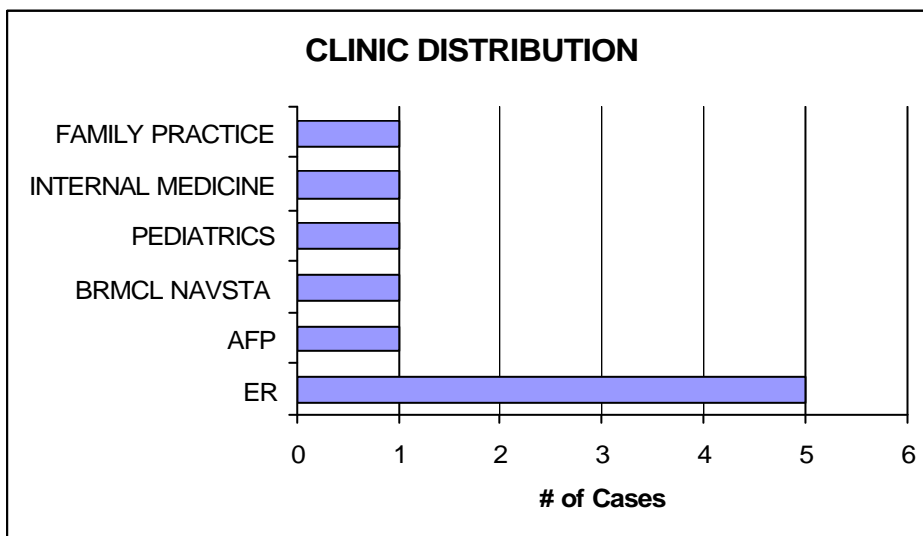

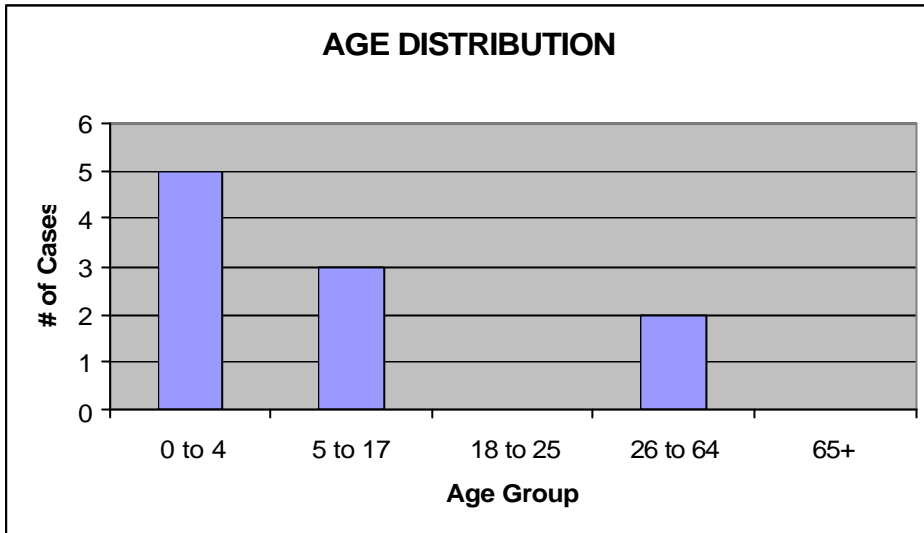


For the period of 8 MAY to 14 MAY 2006:
