 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**

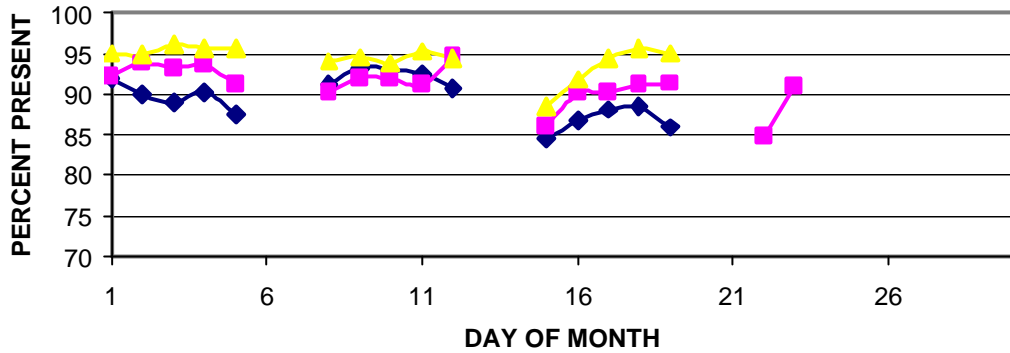


**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE
 GMHA-ED DATA FOR THE PERIOD 7-1-2005 THROUGH 6-31-2006**



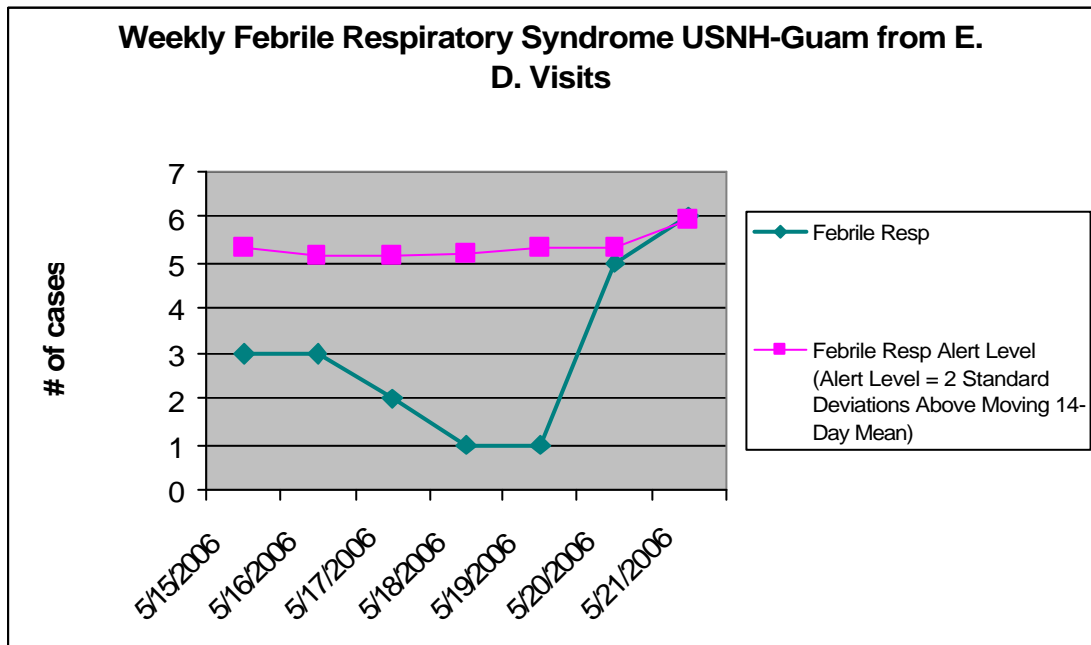
GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE SURVEILLANCE

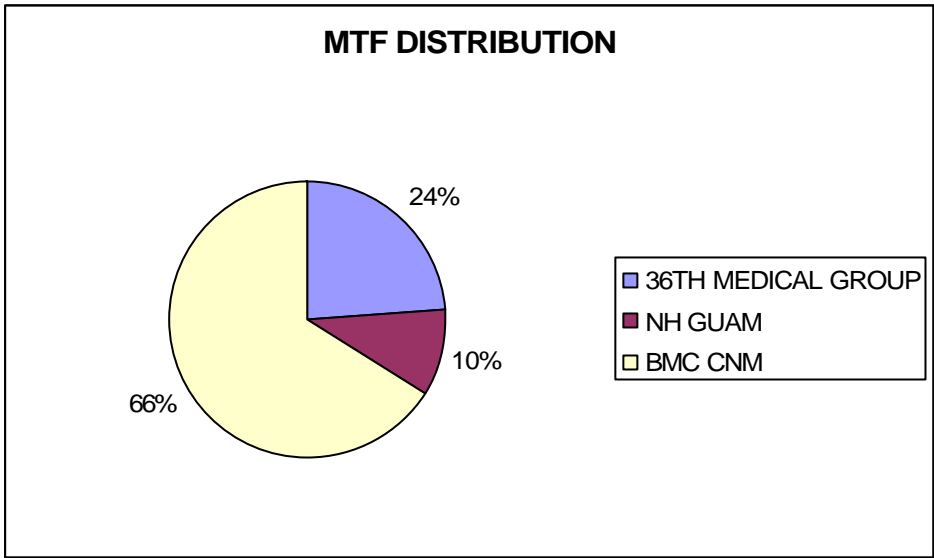

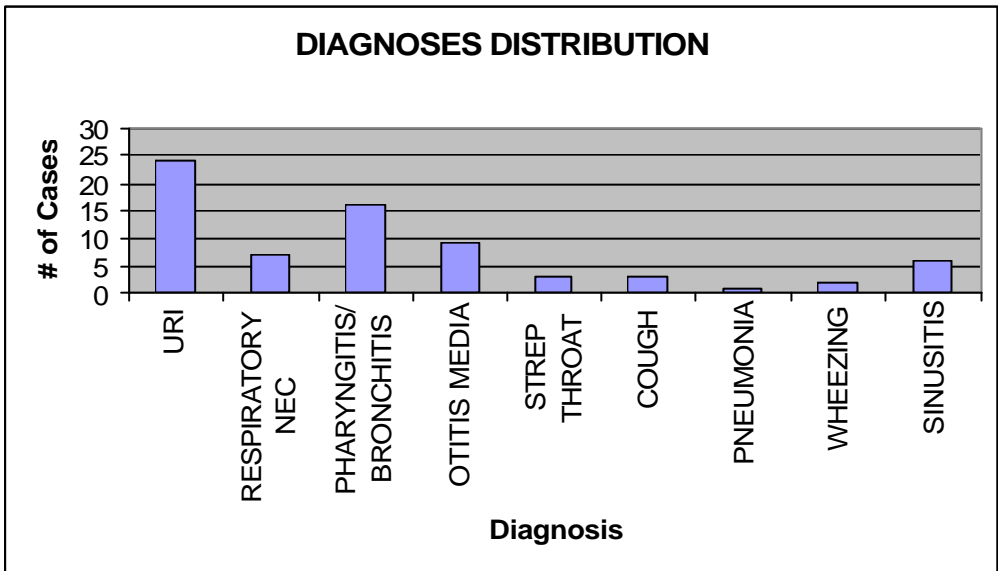

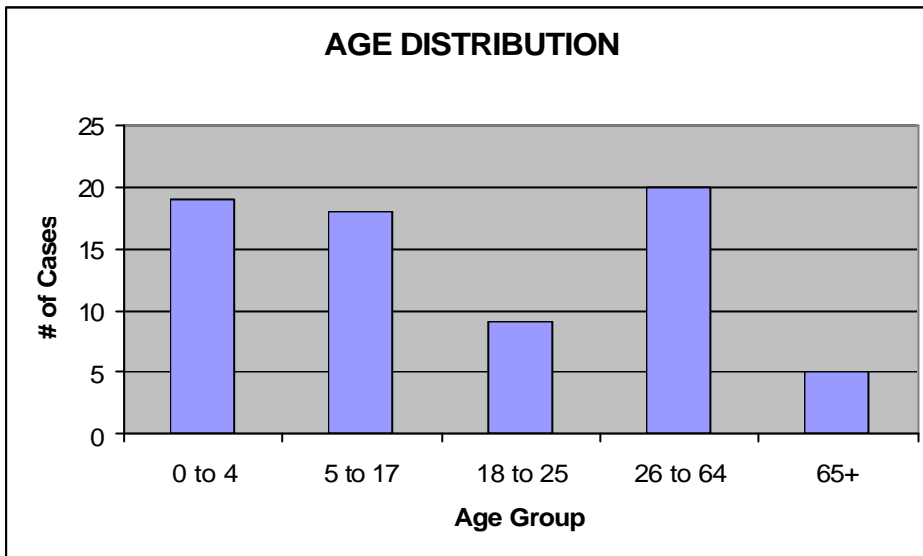
? An increase in respiratory cases was noted via Essence for 16 May 2006. Seventy-one cases were identified. Distribution by Military Treatment Facility was follows:



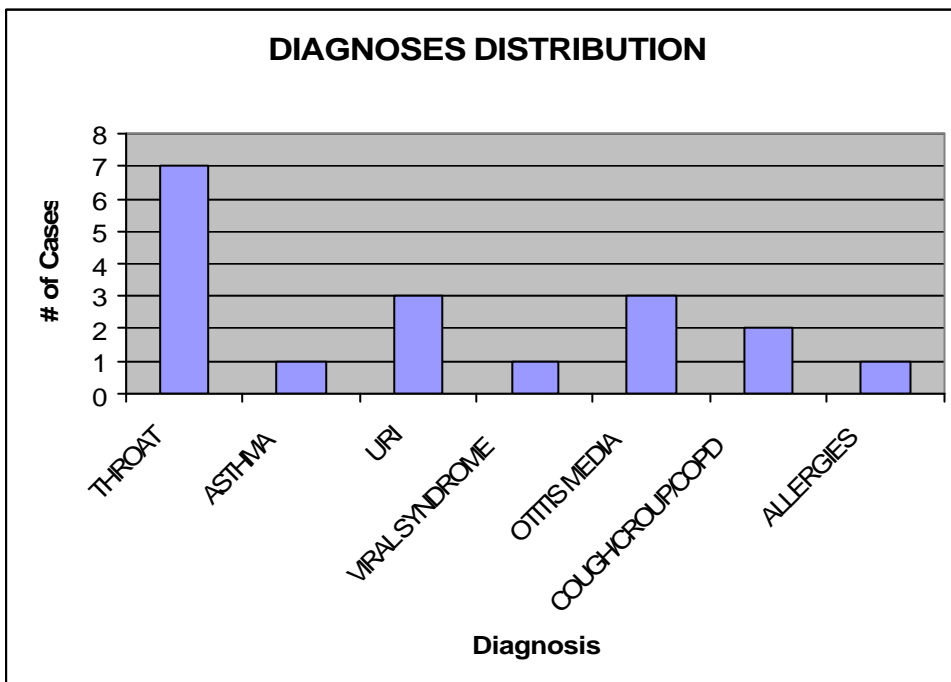
