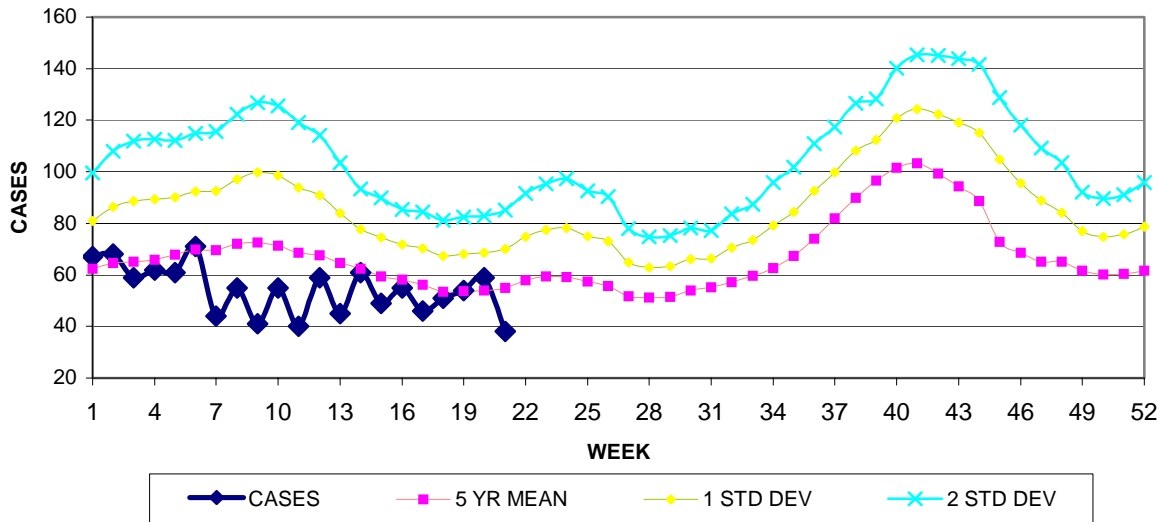

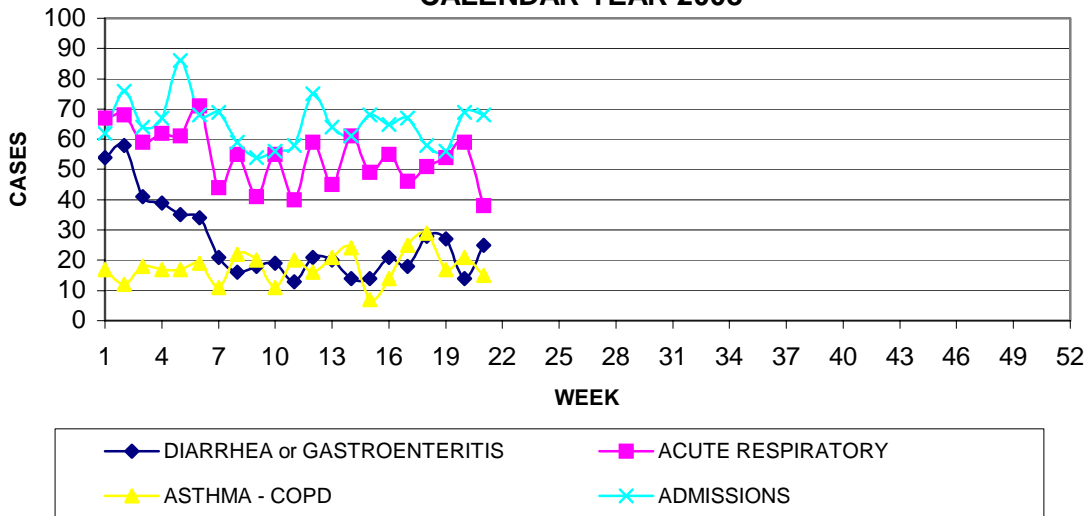

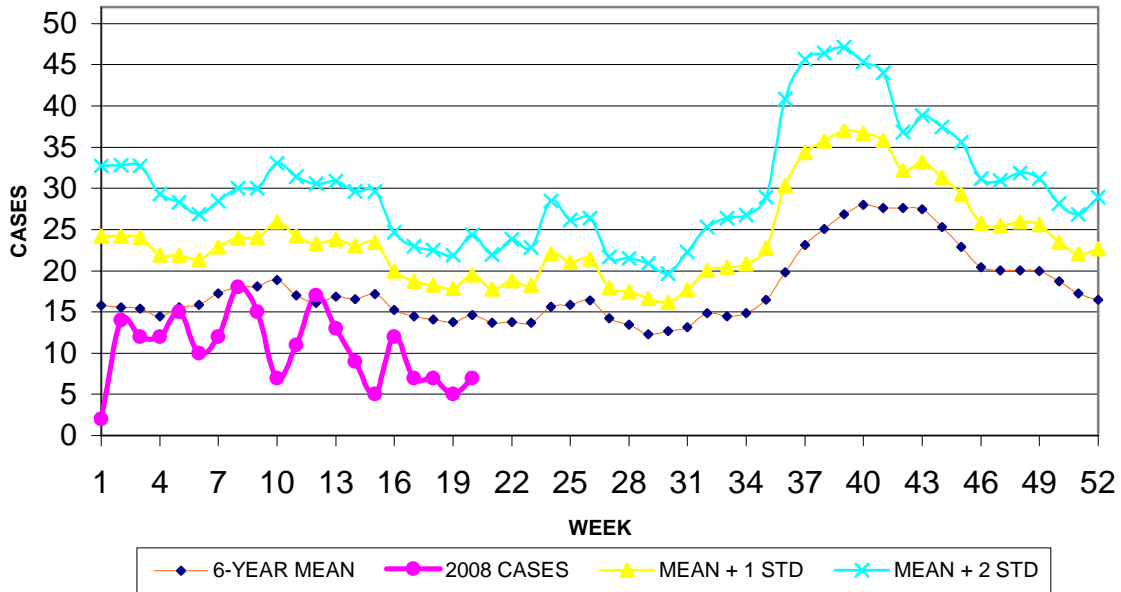

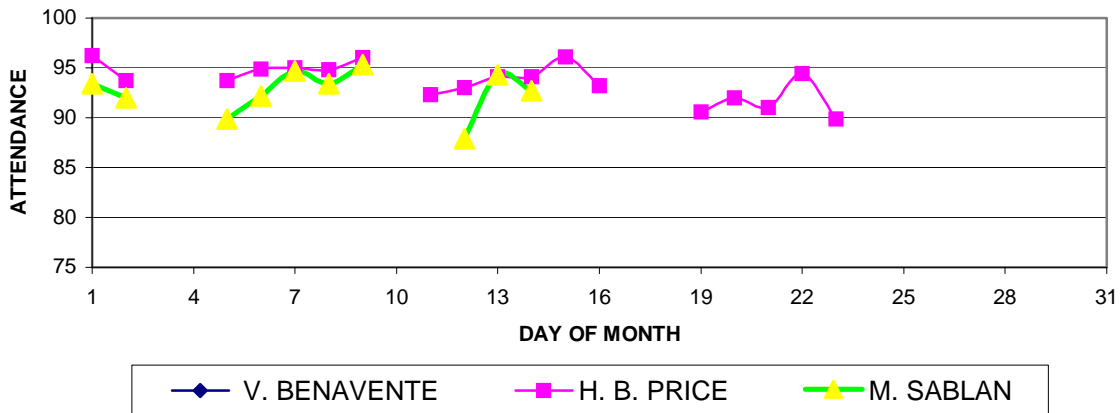

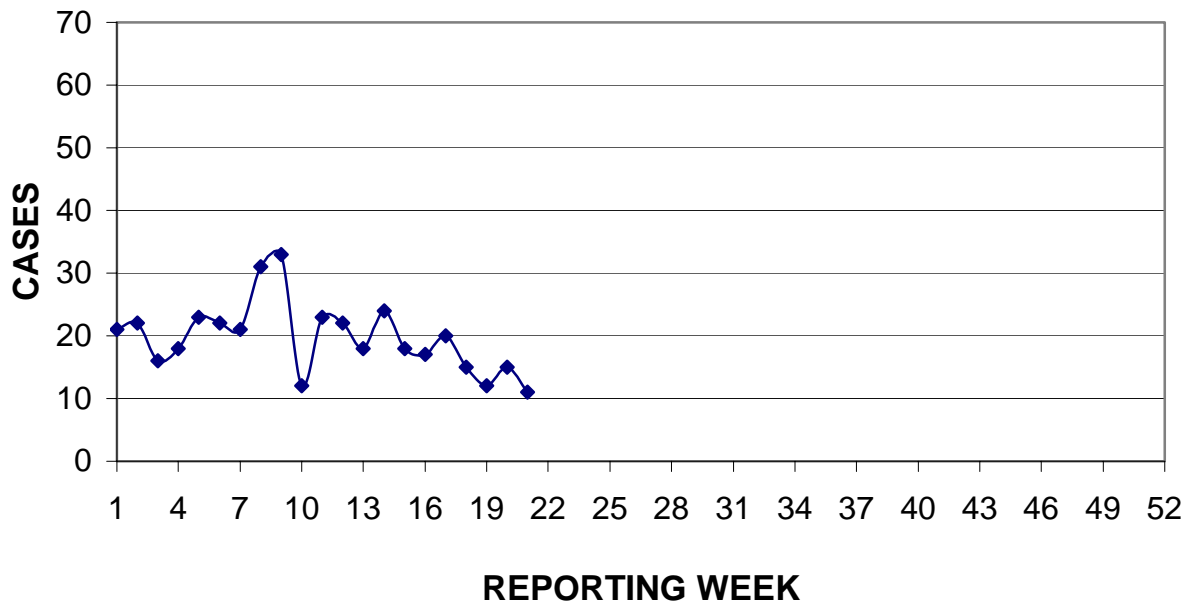

REGIONAL EPI-NEWS

The Republic of Kiribati reports a recent increase in patients seen with fever and severe headache; dengue is suspected but has not been confirmed. Betio Hospital has seen as many as 70 patients in a single day with this syndrome and 1 death has been attributed to the outbreak.

The Republic of Belau reports that dengue cases are still occurring there but at a reduced rate. A total of 6 cases were seen in April.
