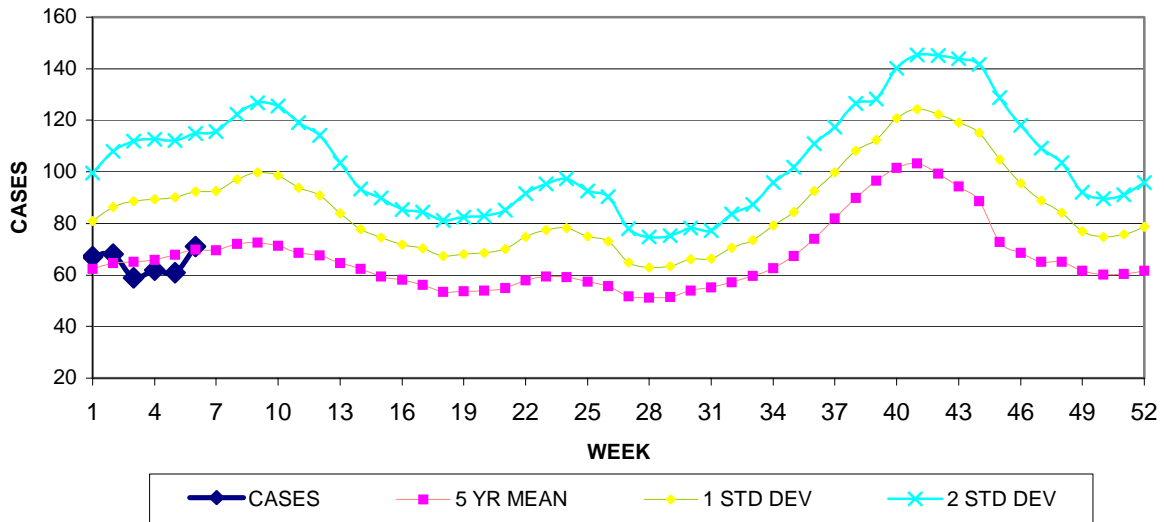

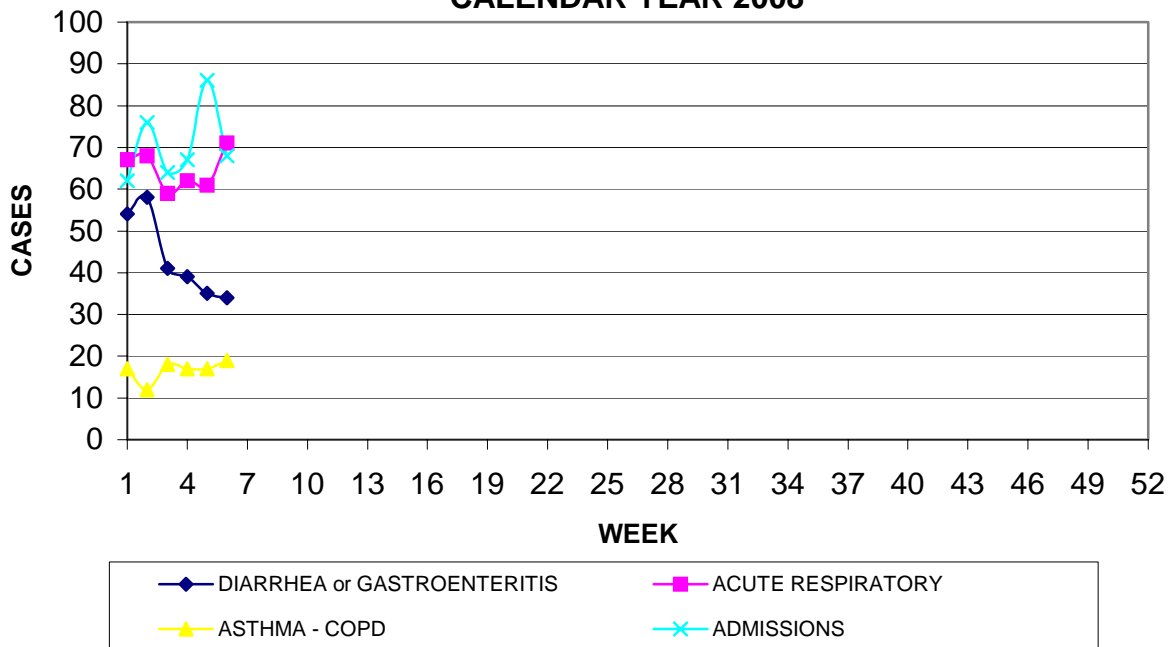

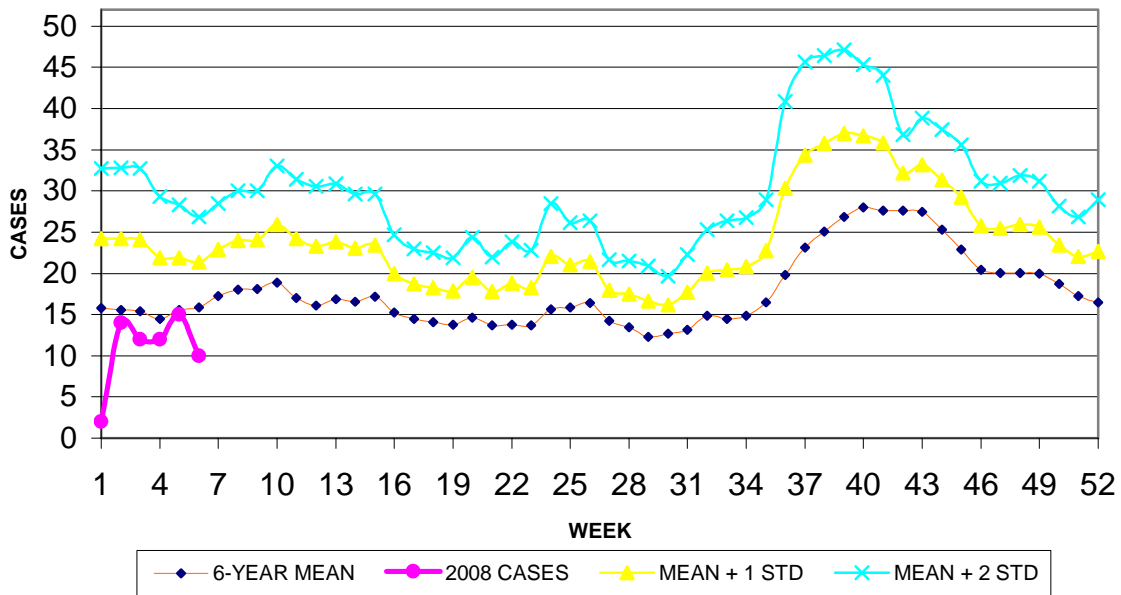
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY INFECTION SURVEILLANCE, 2008;  
 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**



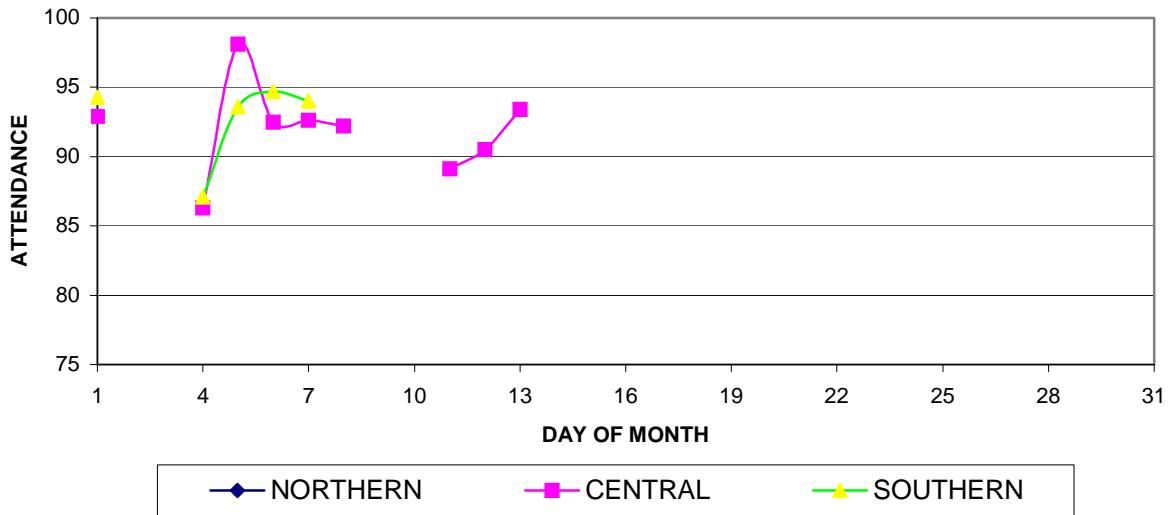
**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE

 CALENDAR YEAR 2008**



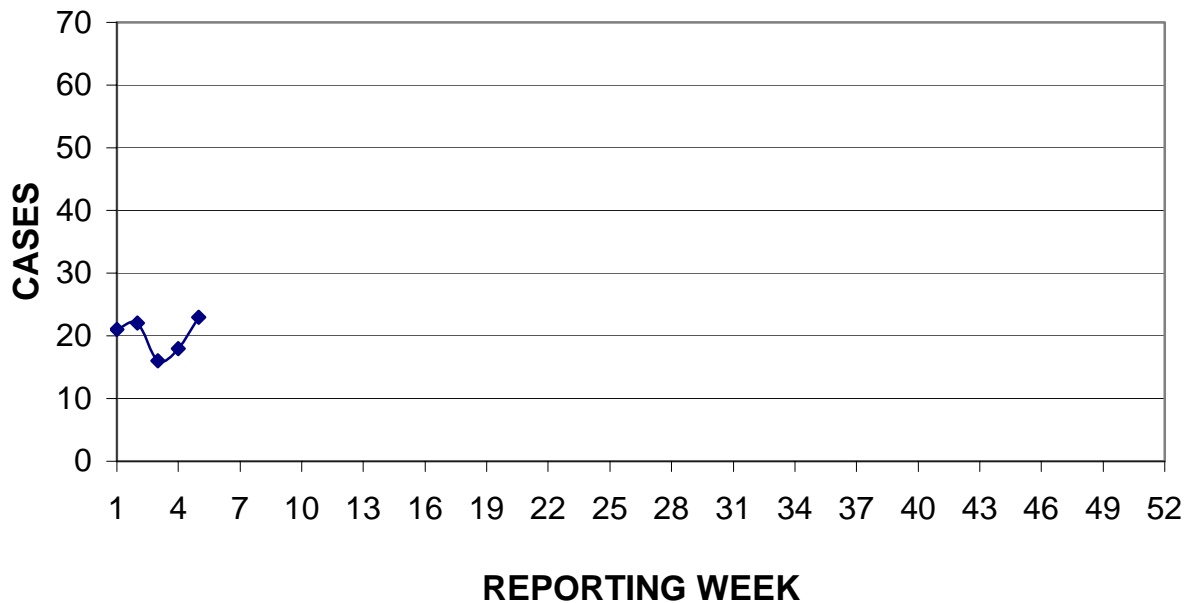
