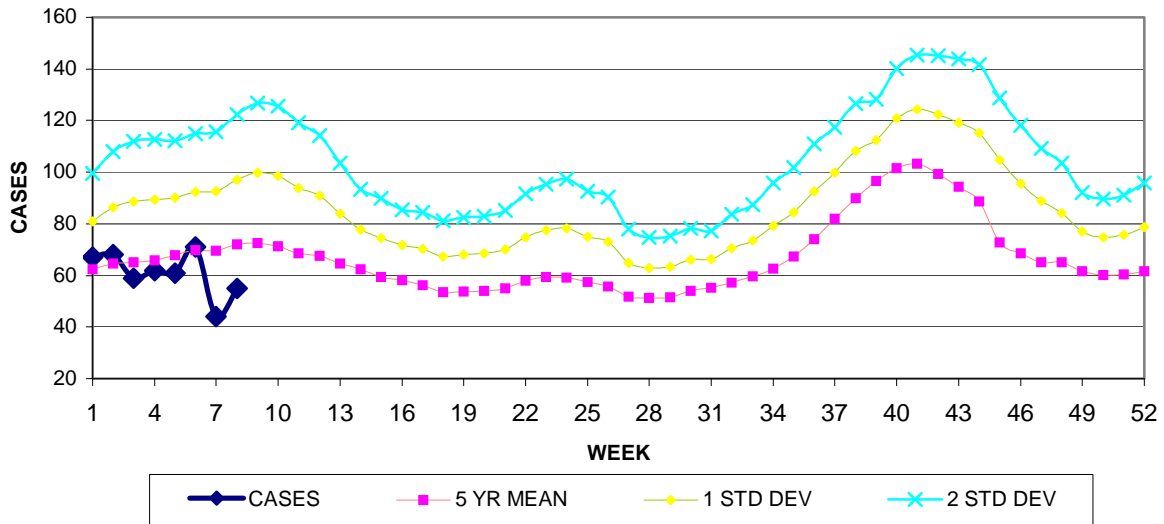

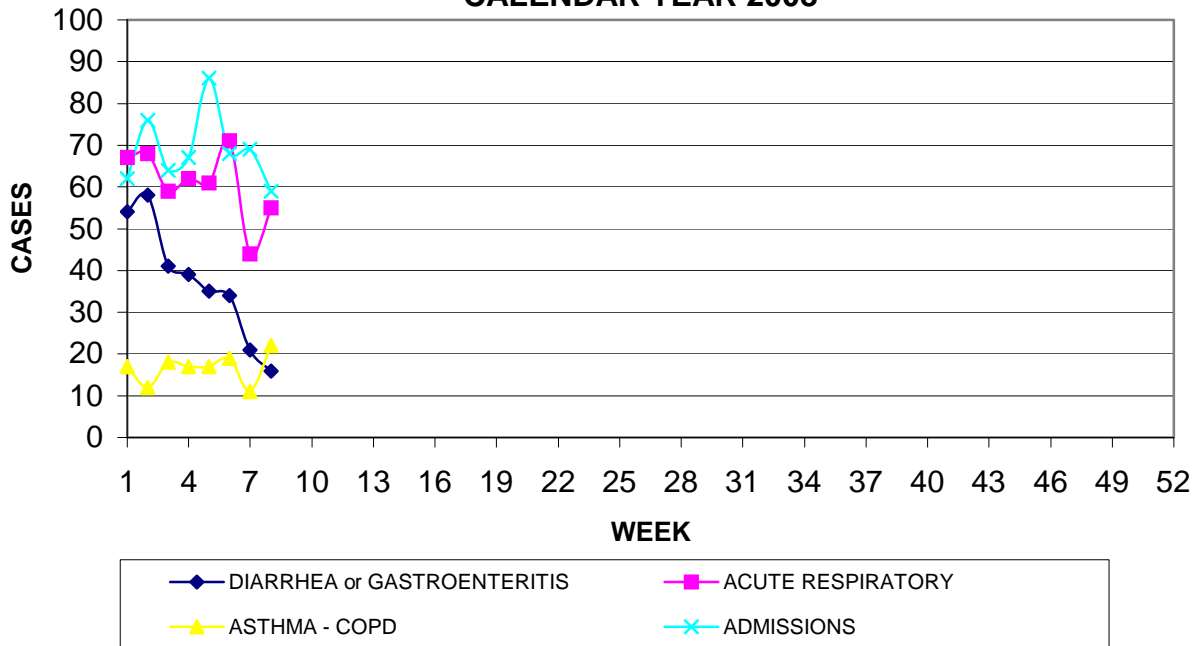

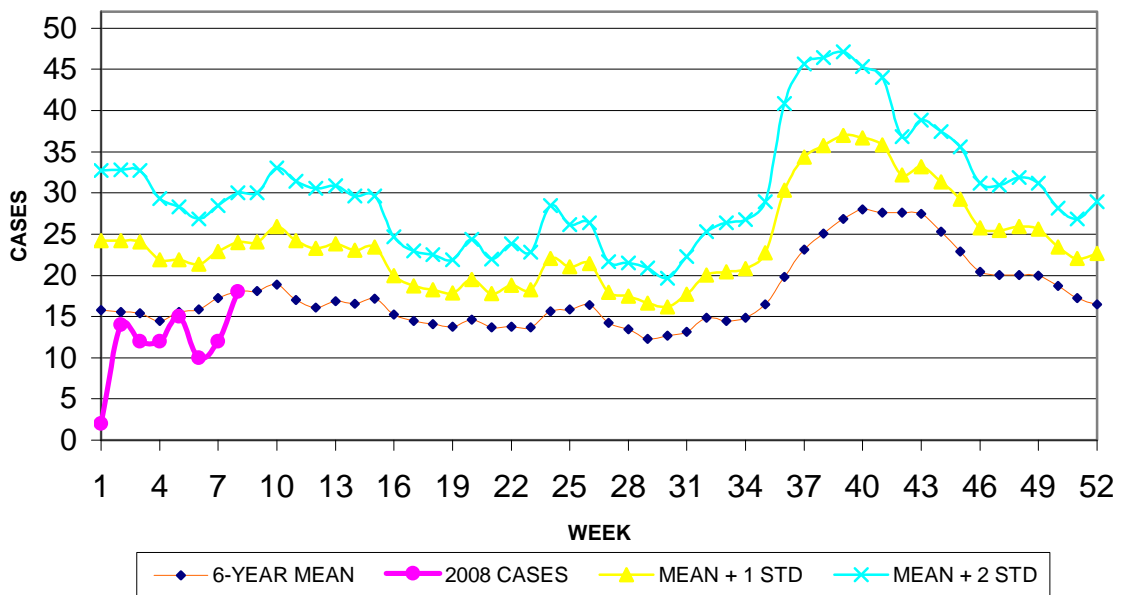
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY INFECTION SURVEILLANCE, 2008;
 NUMBER OF PATIENTS SEEN IN THE GMHA-ED BY WEEK SEEN**



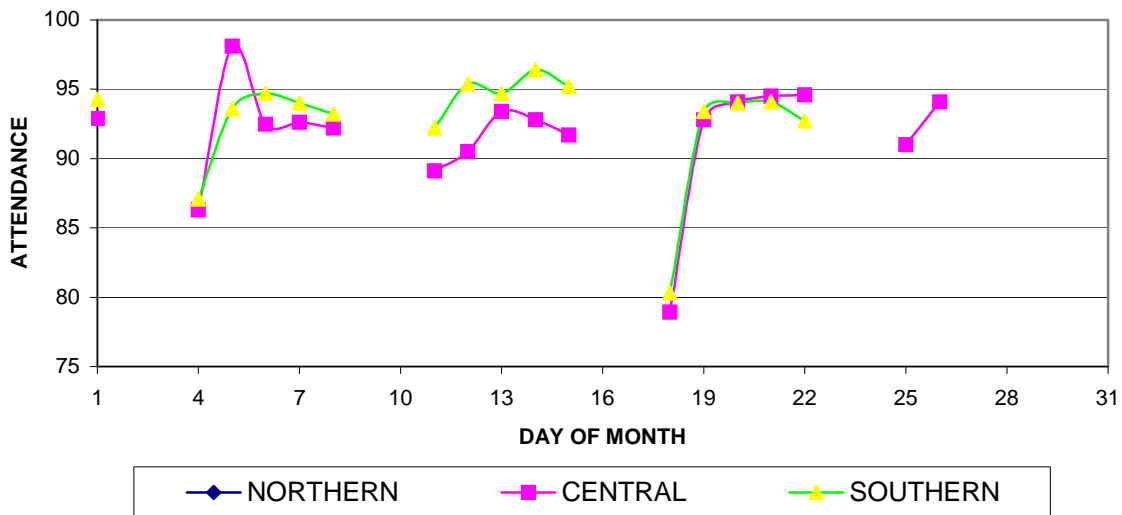
**GUAM SYNDROMIC DISEASE SURVEILLANCE

 CALENDAR YEAR 2008**



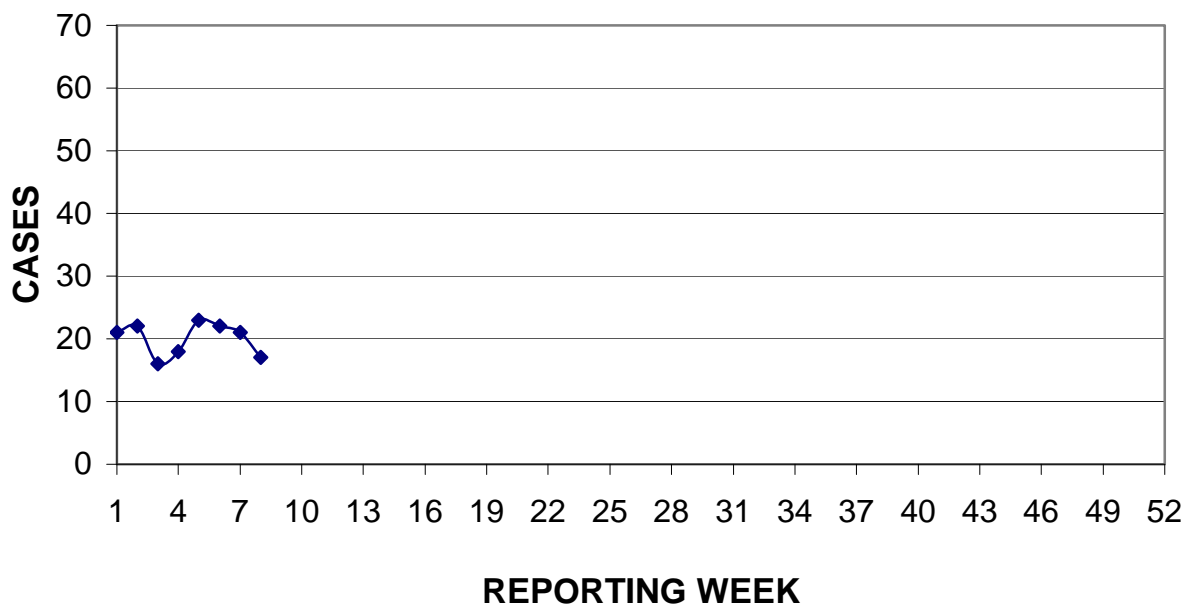

This is the third laboratory-confirmed case of Dengue to be reported this year on Guam and indicates that the disease is active in several countries frequently visited by Guam residents. Guam health care providers are encouraged to be alert for additional possible cases and to report them immediately to Public Health without waiting for laboratory confirmation.
