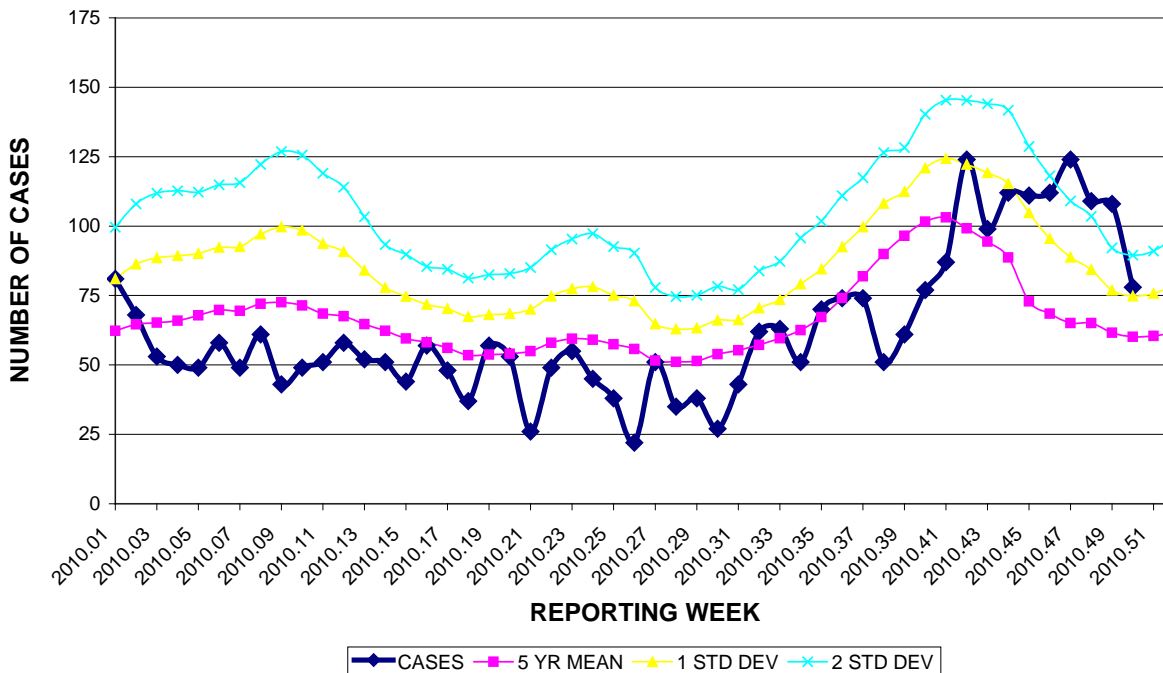
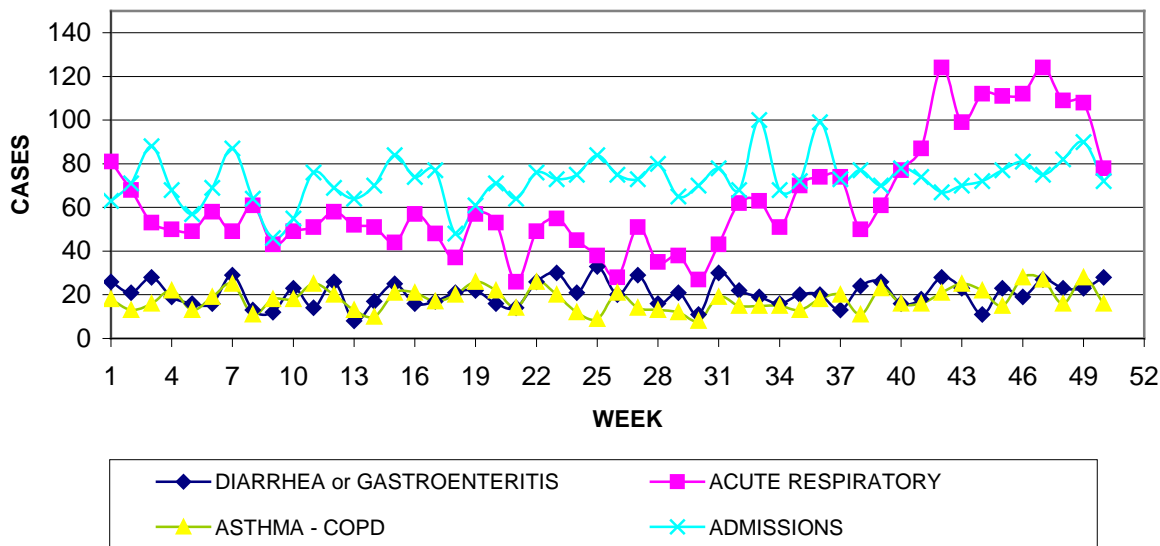

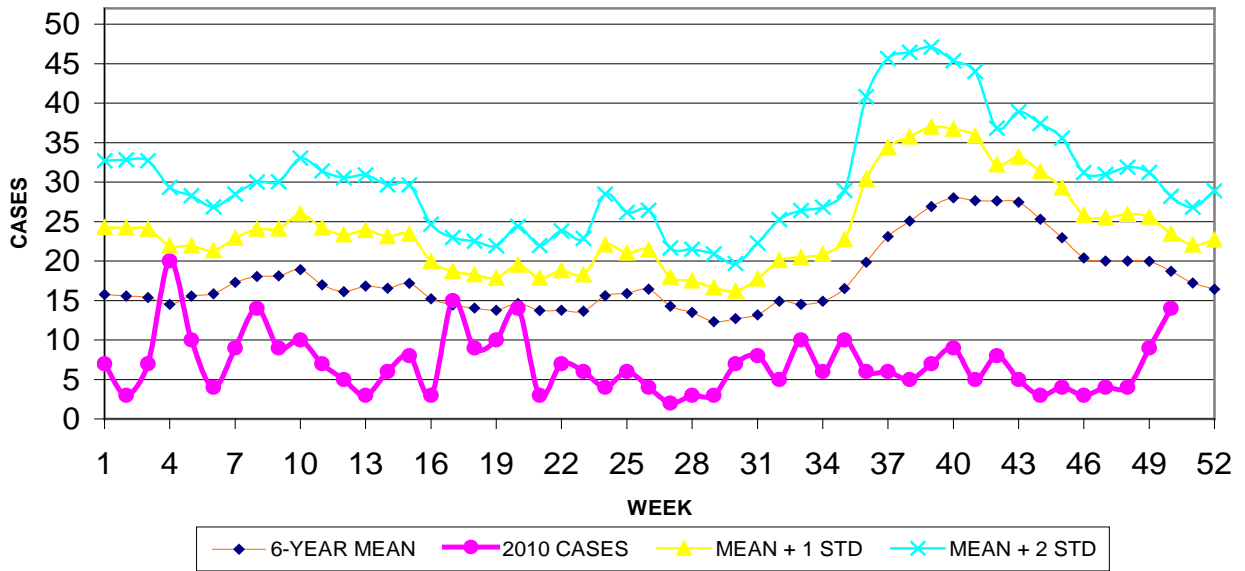
**GUAM ACUTE RESPIRATORY DISEASE SURVEILLANCE, 2010**

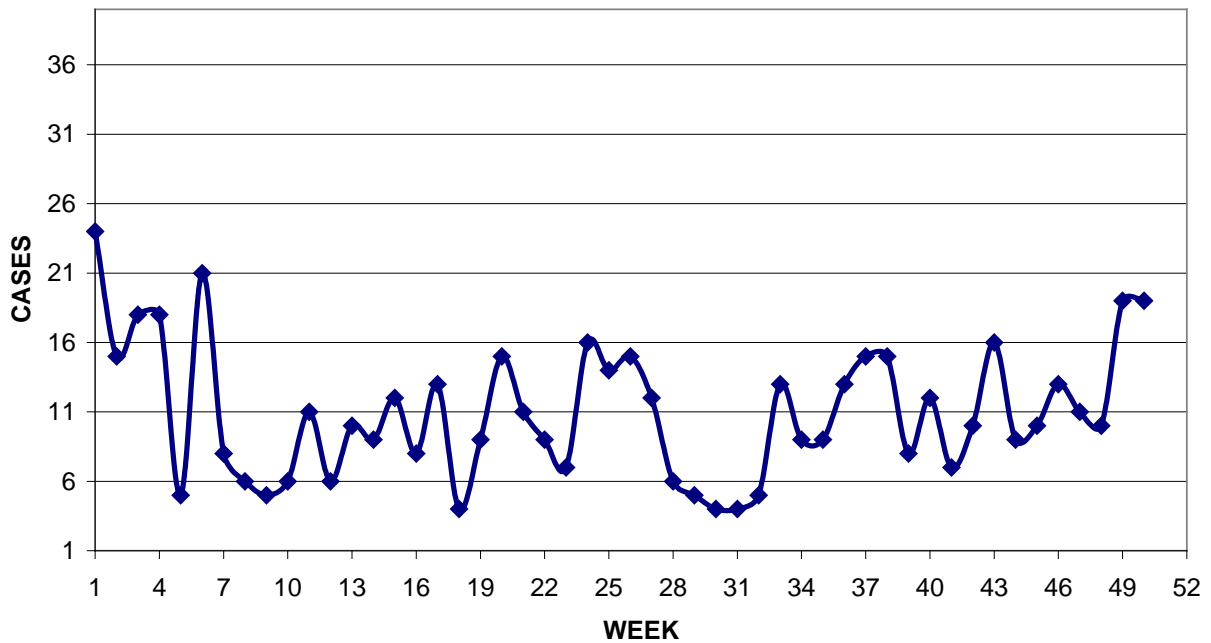

## LOCAL NEWS

On December 6, 2010, *V. cholerae* was isolated from the stool of a patient seen in the GHHA-ED complaining of diarrhea. The patient had eaten shrimp kelaguin (shrimp typically "cooked" by soaking in lemon juice) at a party but claimed that none of the others who attended the party became ill. It was not possible to obtain left-over shrimp or to determine their source. Ongoing syndromic surveillance has not identified a significant increase in diarrheal illnesses but Guam health care professionals are urged to remain alert to the possibility of additional cases.
