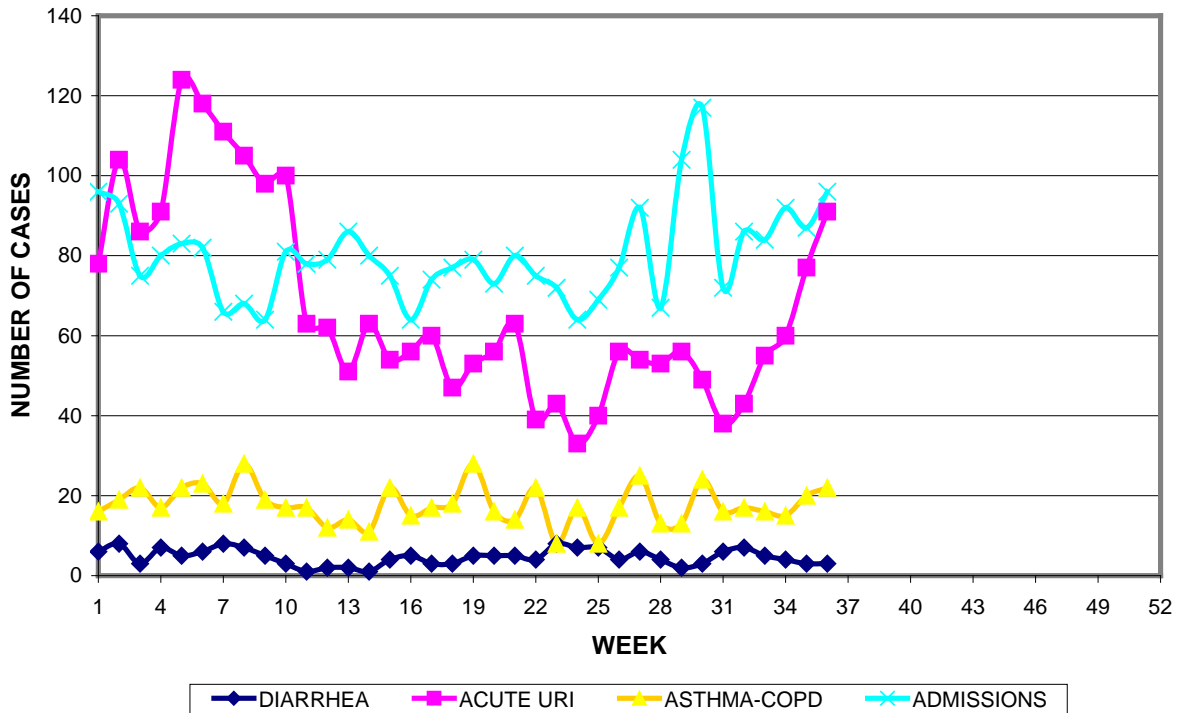

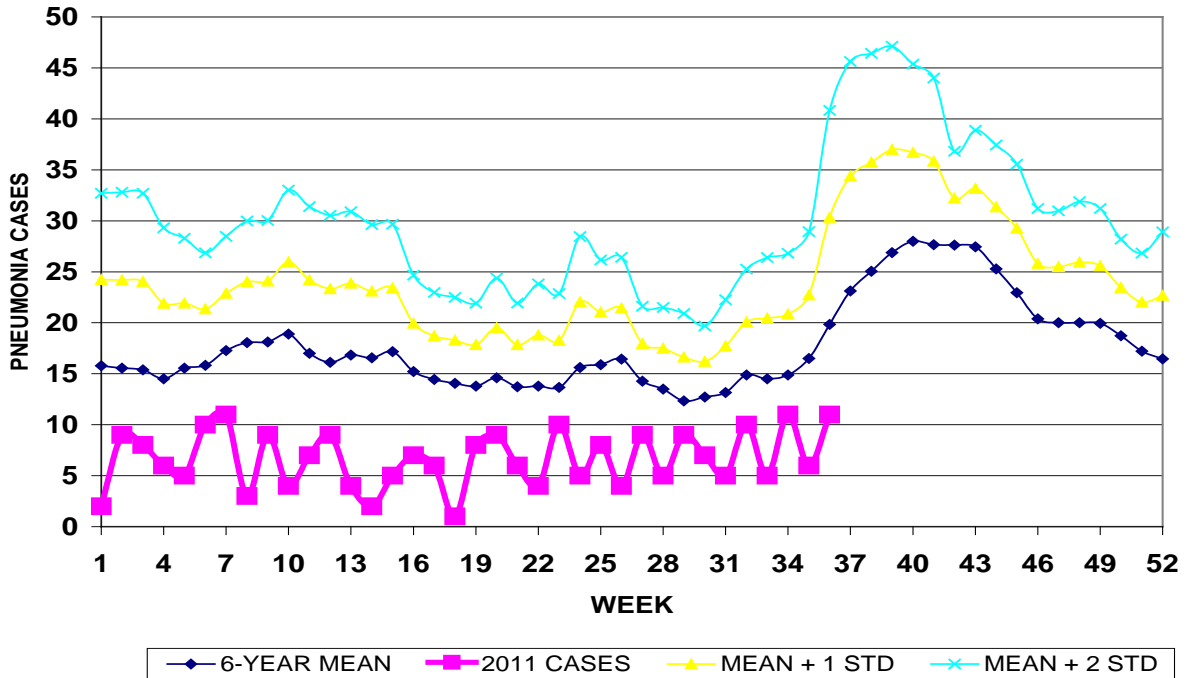

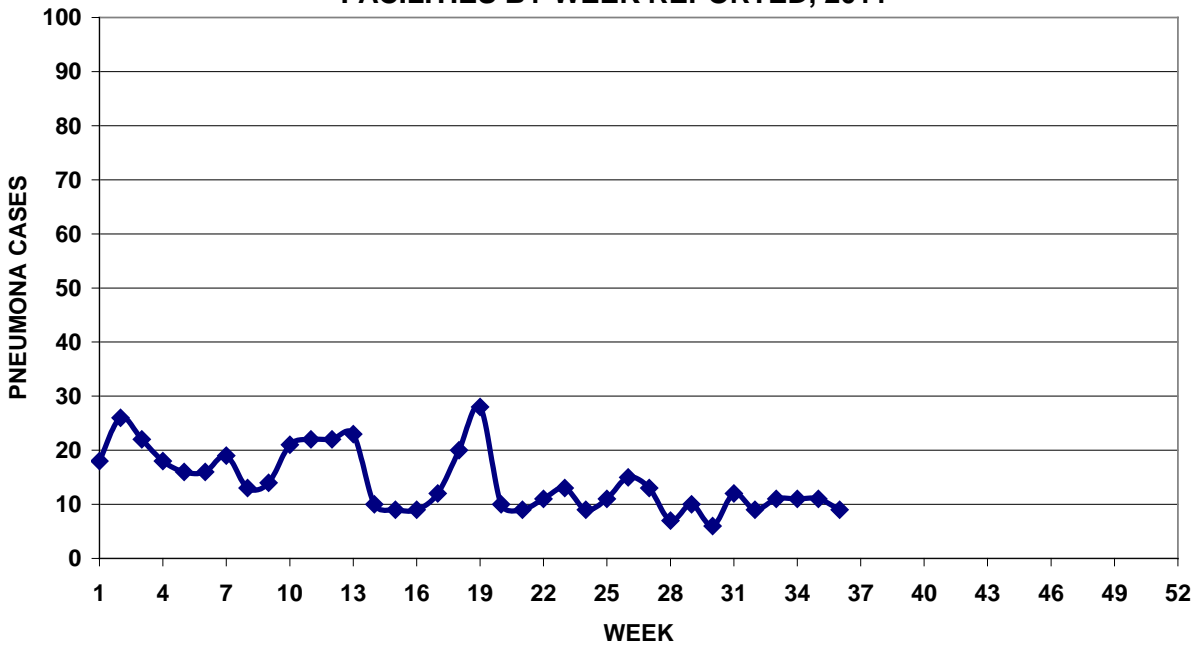

## LOCAL NEWS

As in past years, the start of Guam's new school year has been accompanied by an increase of acute respiratory disease cases treated in the GMHA Emergency Department (see first chart). To provide an early warning of any pending outbreak of influenza, physicians are requested to have suspect cases of influenza tested and to report the results to Public Health.
