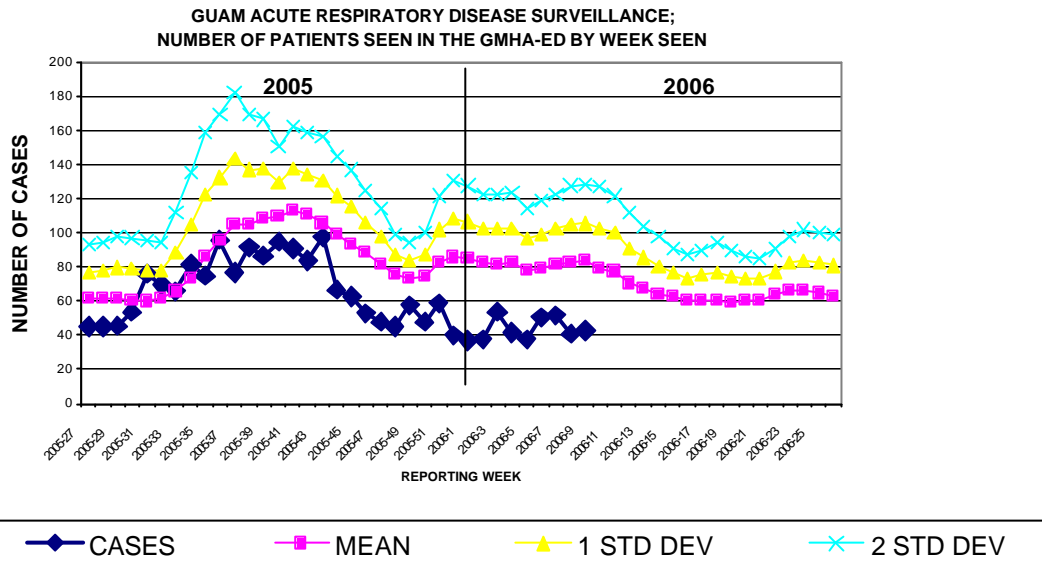

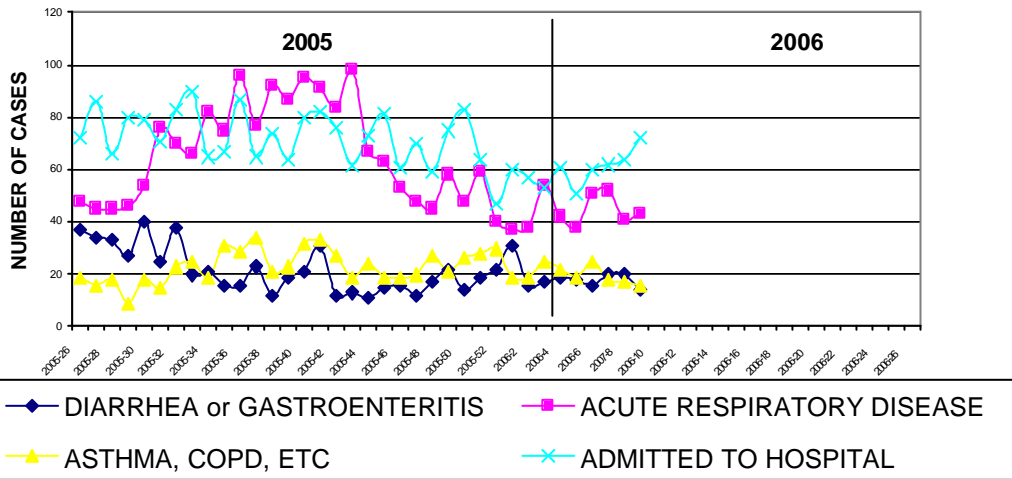

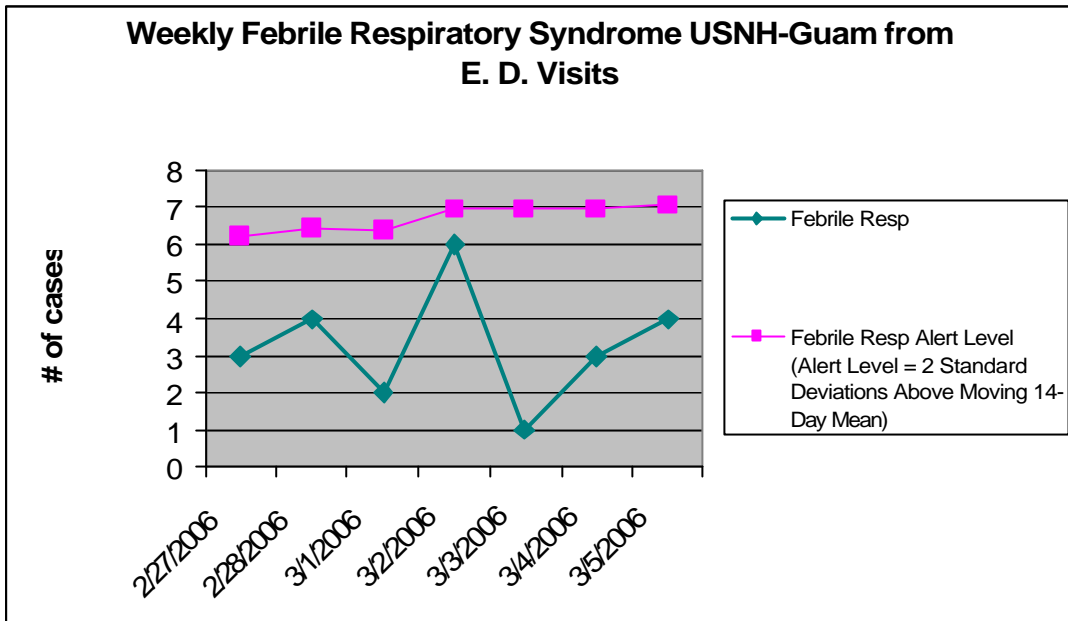


**Guam Syndromic Disease Surveillance by Week: Data from the GMHA-ED Log
 for the Period from 7-3-2005 Through 7-1-2006**



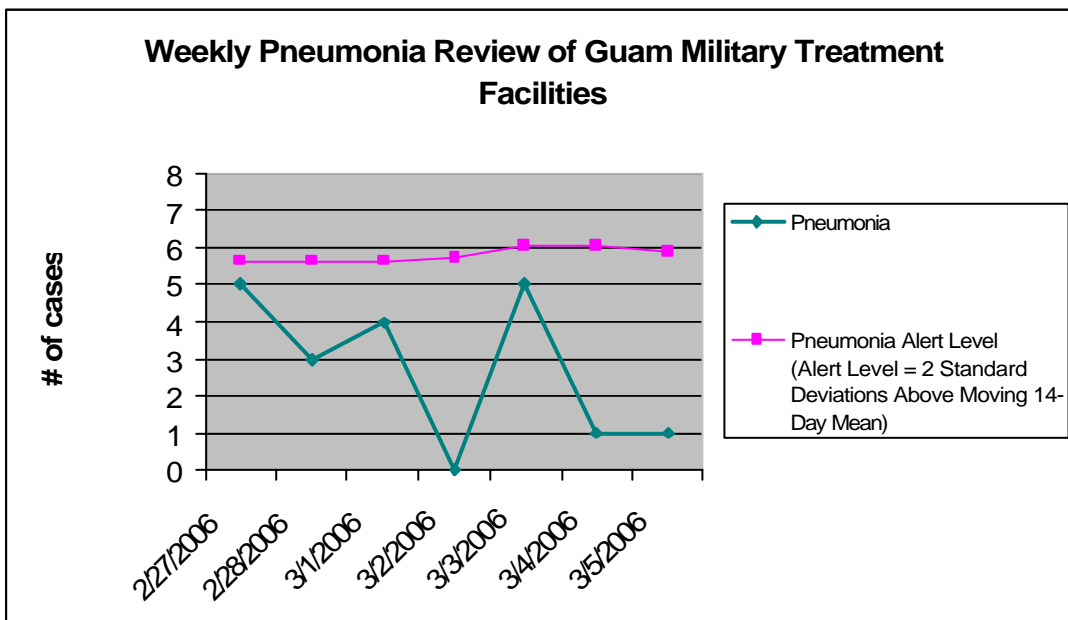

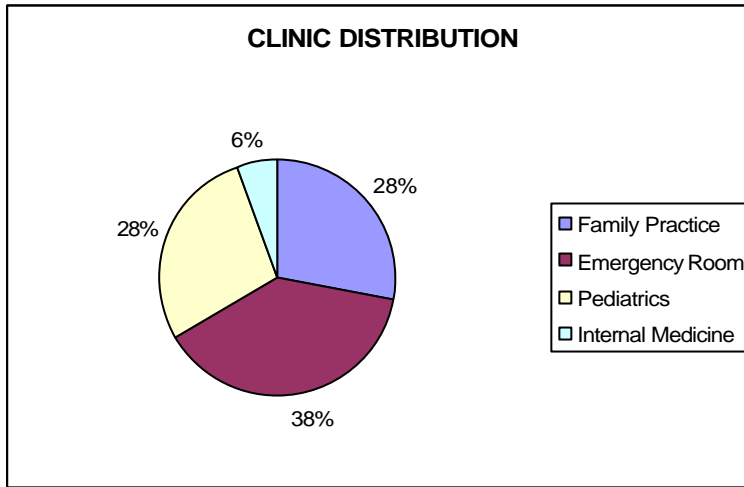

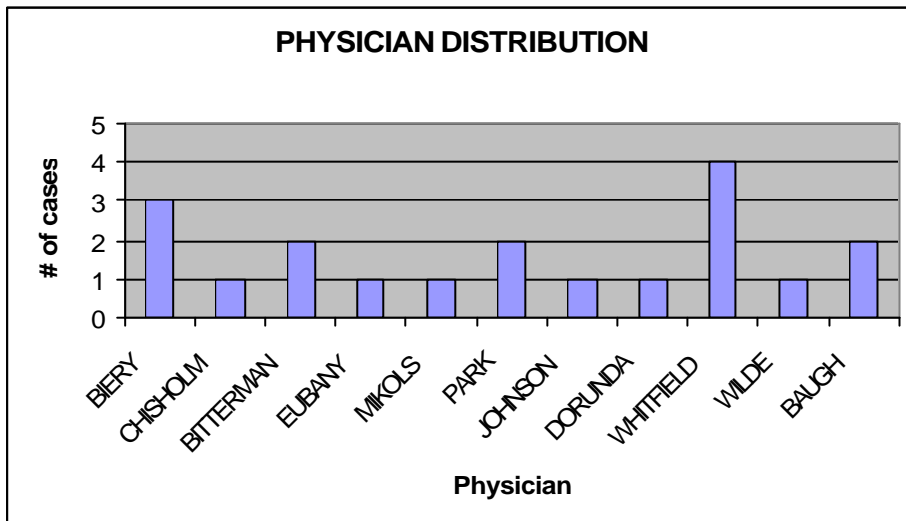
For the period of 27 FEB to 5 MAR 2006:
