General comment on reported syndromes:

A/ Evolution of number of cases for the 8 selected syndromes, for Monday September 2nd

Participating sites for Monday the 2nd: Three dispensaries in Wallis and one dispensary in Futuna reporting. Work is ongoing to make the six temporary sentinel sites set up specifically for the Mini Games fully operational.

- **Acute Fever & Rash:** 1 case observed in a patient who has travelled to the Mini Games from French Polynesia.
- **Watery Diarrhoea:** No cases observed.
- **Non-Watery Diarrhoea:** 3 cases reported.
- **Influenza-like-illness:** No cases observed. The slight increase in influenza cases observed last week related to the comparison period is thus not sustained.
- **Prolonged Fever:** 1 case observed in a patient who has travelled to the Mini Games from Papua New Guinea. Malaria was suspected, but smears and rapid test for malaria were negative.
- **Acute Fever & Neurological symptoms:** No cases observed.
- **Food borne:** No cases observed.
- **Heat-related-illness:** No cases observed.

Conclusion/recommendations:

- Continue setting up six reporting sites to be operational during the games
- Further investigation is ongoing on the case of Prolonged Fever from Papua New Guinea. Further analysis are being done including dengue fever, chikungunya and leptospirosis
- The case of Acute Fever and Rash from French Polynesia should be further followed up and tested for dengue infection, and further differential diagnostics if necessary.
