





## September 27<sup>th</sup>

Evolution of number of cases for the 8 selected syndromes, for Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> 2013

Participating sites: Three dispensaries in Wallis and one dispensary in Futuna reporting.

The last day of the Mini Games was on 12-09-2013 and the sites set up specifically for the Mini Games have stopped reporting, and only the four dispensaries keep reporting until Friday 27 of September, to cover the incubation period of disease under surveillance.

- Acute Fever & Rash: No cases reported.
- Watery Diarrhoea: No cases reported.
- Non-Watery Diarrhoea: 2 cases reported.
- Influenza-like-Illness: 7 cases reported.
- Prolonged Fever: No cases reported.
- Acute Fever & Neurological symptoms: No cases reported.
- Food borne disease outbreak: No cases reported.
- Heat-related-Illness: No cases reported.

## **Conclusion/recommendations:**

- 2 sites did not report on Wednesday the 25<sup>th</sup> and Thursday the 26<sup>th</sup> and are encouraged to keep reporting. The graphs will be updated as soon as all the data will be entered.
- No samples were taken yesterday. Sites are encouraged to take an NPS sample for ILI cases.
   3 to 5 NPS by week are recommended to ensure a quality lab-based surveillance.
