The "routine surveillance" pages of PPHSN website were created in 2006 to host routine surveillance reports/newsletters received from Pacific Island countries and territories (PICTs) for the target diseases of PPHSN (dengue fever, measles, rubella, influenza, leptospirosis, cholera, typhoid fever, SARS, HIV and STIs) and other communicable diseases. Guam was the first territory to contribute to these pages, through the Guam Epidemiology Newsletter produced weekly.

Now, reports from eight other PICTs (Federated States of Micronesia, French Polynesia, Kiribati, Nauru, New Caledonia, Palau, Samoa and Wallis and Futuna) are also posted on the pages. The reports are available in their original language (English or French). Excerpts of the information contained in these reports are also sent on PacNet when relevant.
